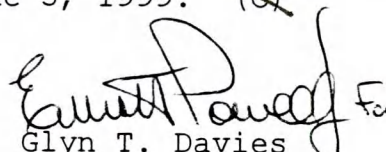

- SACEUR should have a plan to increase the intensity of air strikes if Belgrade refuses to conclude an adequate military-technical agreement with COMARRC. (Action: JCS) (S)

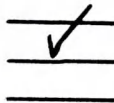

- The USG will encourage the establishment of a civil-military operations center or comparable capability in KFOR to help coordinate military operations and civil implementation.
(Action: JCS) (C)
- The USG will ensure that KFOR has adequate liaison to the Kosovo Liberation Army. (Action: JCS) (C)
- A suspension of air strikes should include a suspension of all air operations over the FRY with the exception of Kosovo.
(Action: State, DOD) (S)
