The Department of State has requested an amendment to Secretary Albright's request for Special Air Missions Aircraft for her trip to Rome and Kosovo. She will now travel from Rome to Pristina, Kosovo and return on July 29, 1999, followed by travel to Aviano Air Base on July 30 to join the President for his participation in the Sarajevo Stability Pact Leaders Conference. The Secretary will return to Washington with the Presidential party.

The Department of State has requested that a Special Air Mission in-theater aircraft be provided to transport the Secretary and her staff from Rome, Italy to Aviano Air Base on the morning of July 30 since the 89th SAM aircraft will be in required crew rest status after returning from Pristina, Kosovo the night before. There are no commercial flights from Rome to Aviano Air Base which would allow the Secretary to join the President in time for her early morning departure from Aviano Air Base to Sarajevo, Bosnia.

As the overall trip had already been approved as a Presidential Mission, the Department of State has requested that a Special Air Missions aircraft be made available on a non-reimbursable basis to transport the Secretary and her party for this one additional, important day. I support this request.

In furtherance of the President's foreign policy Secretary Albright must travel from Rome to Pristina, Kosovo and return on July 29, 1999. The Secretary must then travel to Aviano Air Force Base on July 30 to join President Clinton for his participation in the Sarajevo Stability Pact Leaders Conference. The Secretary will return to Washington with the Presidential party.

We request that a Special Air Mission in-theater aircraft be provided to transport the Secretary and her staff from Rome, Italy to Aviano Air Force Base on the morning of July 30 since the 89th SAM aircraft will be in required crew rest status after returning from Pristina, Kosovo the previous night. There are no commercial flights from Rome to Aviano Air Force Base which would allow the Secretary to join the President in time for his early morning departure from Aviano Air Force Base to Sarajevo, Bosnia.

Given the urgency of the situation, we request that these air assets be made available on a non-reimbursable basis. This will provide needed support stemming from security concerns, and enable necessary communications links to be maintained.
