While still at the State Department, I met with Craig Johnstone of the American Chamber of Commerce about ways to promote U.S. business interests in Kosovo. He pursued this in a subsequent meeting after I moved to Treasury. On Friday, Johnstone called to say that AmCham President Donahue is willing to travel to Kosovo for the day on Saturday, September 18 (he will be in Budapest on the 17th and will be traveling on to Moscow for meetings on September 20).
