Energy chief returns home to stump for health plan

Trying to bolster thinking support

U.S. Secretary of Energy Hazel Reid O'Leary came back to her hometown Saturday, stumping for President Clinton's health care proposal and greeting old friends.

Some polls show declining grassroots support for the president's plan, so O'Leary and others

in the administration are taking his message around the country.

O'Leary shared a headline from Thursday's Wall Street Journal with the nearly 100 people gathered at the United Steel Workers of America Local 8888 headquarters on Huntington Avenue. It read, "Many Don't Realize It's Clinton Plan They Like."

According to the article, 45 percent of respondents in the Wall Street Journal/NBC News poll said they oppose the Clinton

plan, up from 18 percent in September when it was unveiled. But without knowing it is Clinton's plan, 76 percent of those polled said they like its basic provisions, the article said.

O'Leary blamed eroding support on special interest groups spending big advertising dollars to kill the plan. But she said conflicting statements from administration officials and the 1,000-page plus proposal are responsible for some of the con-

fusion.

She said the Clinton plan contains guaranteed health security, competition, choice and reasonable prices.

Employers would offer insurance to every employee, part- or full-time. The government would subsidize some smaller companies and people who could not afford to pay, she said.

O'Leary, who still has family in Newport News, faced a friendly crowd, receiving a standing ovation before she even began speaking. She was invited to speak by Rep. Robert C. Scott, D-Newport News.

Before her talk, she greeted Sarah Whittington, her eighth-grade teacher at the former Huntington High School and now a member of the Newport News School Board.

"I'm really proud of you," Whittington told O'Leary, who has a bachelor's degree from Elsk University and a law degree from Rutgers University.

Whittington was the first of several people to ask about business owners' reaction to the plan.

O'Leary acknowledged that big companies would subsidize smaller companies at first.

In the long term, equal access

to preventive medicine would reduce catastrophic illnesses and cost the system so much money. Everyone would be better off, she said.

Other questions ranged from how the plan would be financed to inclusion of mental health services and dental benefits.

One man contended there was a health care crisis, pointing out even illegal immigrants injured in a recent truck wreck were treated free at a California hospital. O'Leary said it was unfair to blame those who use that hospital must subsidize those who cannot pay, some hospitals just turn in people away.

O'Leary spent little time on a platform, where a parade of posters proclaimed "Health That's Always There." Instead, she used a portable sound system to walk around the room, tentatively to questioners and to answer questions in return.

O'Leary, who is from a family of physicians, held up a sample Health Security card that everyone would carry under Clinton's plan.

"I hope in his lifetime he will be using this," said O'Leary, handing the card to Kenneth Lewis Chesapeake. The boy's father works at Newport News Shipbuilding, brought him to hear the speech.

"The nation has been grappling with this issue for nearly decades," O'Leary said. "Let's fix it."

Hartford school clinic impresses EPA chief

The nation's top environmental official toured a one-of-a-kind Hartford clinic Monday, saying she hopes it can be a national model for school-based preventive medical care.

Monday marked the first day of full service at the R.E. Betances elementary school's I Believe in the Children Clinic, which provides primary, preventive and acute medical care for Betances students.

U.S. Sen. Christopher J. Dodd,

D-Conn. U.S. Rep. Barbara B. Kennelly, D-1st District, and Carol M. Browner, head of the Environmental Protection Agency, toured the clinic Monday and met with second- and third-grade students.

"The point of today's visit is to see a clinic we hope will be a model for the country," said Browner. "It's our hope and the president's hope this will be a model for school-based clinics."

Plans for the clinic, which started three years ago, were realized through the combined efforts of the Hartford public schools, Hartford Hospital and the Travelers

Cos. Foundation, which provided \$450,000 as initial three-year funding.

The clinic officially opened in February, but was not fully staffed until Monday.

A child psychologist, pediatrician, clinic manager and psychiatric social worker take shifts during school hours to provide developmental and psychological care and some health care for acute and chronic illnesses.

The clinic also provides physical examinations and testing for lead poisoning, which are all required before a student begins

classes.

Of the 26 licensed school-based clinics in Hartford, the Betances clinic is the only one not run exclusively by the school system.

There are similar school clinics in New Haven and Bridgeport, but a computer link to Hartford Hospital would make the Betances clinic unique, said Elaine Brainerd, school health services consultant for the state Department of Education.

In about two weeks, the Betances clinic will be linked by a fax

and telephone line to Hartford Hospital's Pediatric Ambulatory Care Center.

If a student is initially treated in the hospital's emergency room, the child will be recognized as a Betances student.

Medical information will then be sent to the school clinic, which can provide any follow-up treatment.

Eventually, the school and hospital will be connected through a computer network, said Dr. M. Alex Goertman, a pediatrician at Hartford Hospital.

The Betances clinic, Goertman

said, does not have the money now for the on-line system, and there are several ethical and legal questions about patient confidentiality that need to be resolved before the system is installed.

The Betances clinic is one of two that would serve as models in Hartford for linking a school and a medical facility. A similar proposed system would link Weaver High School with the Burdick Health Center.

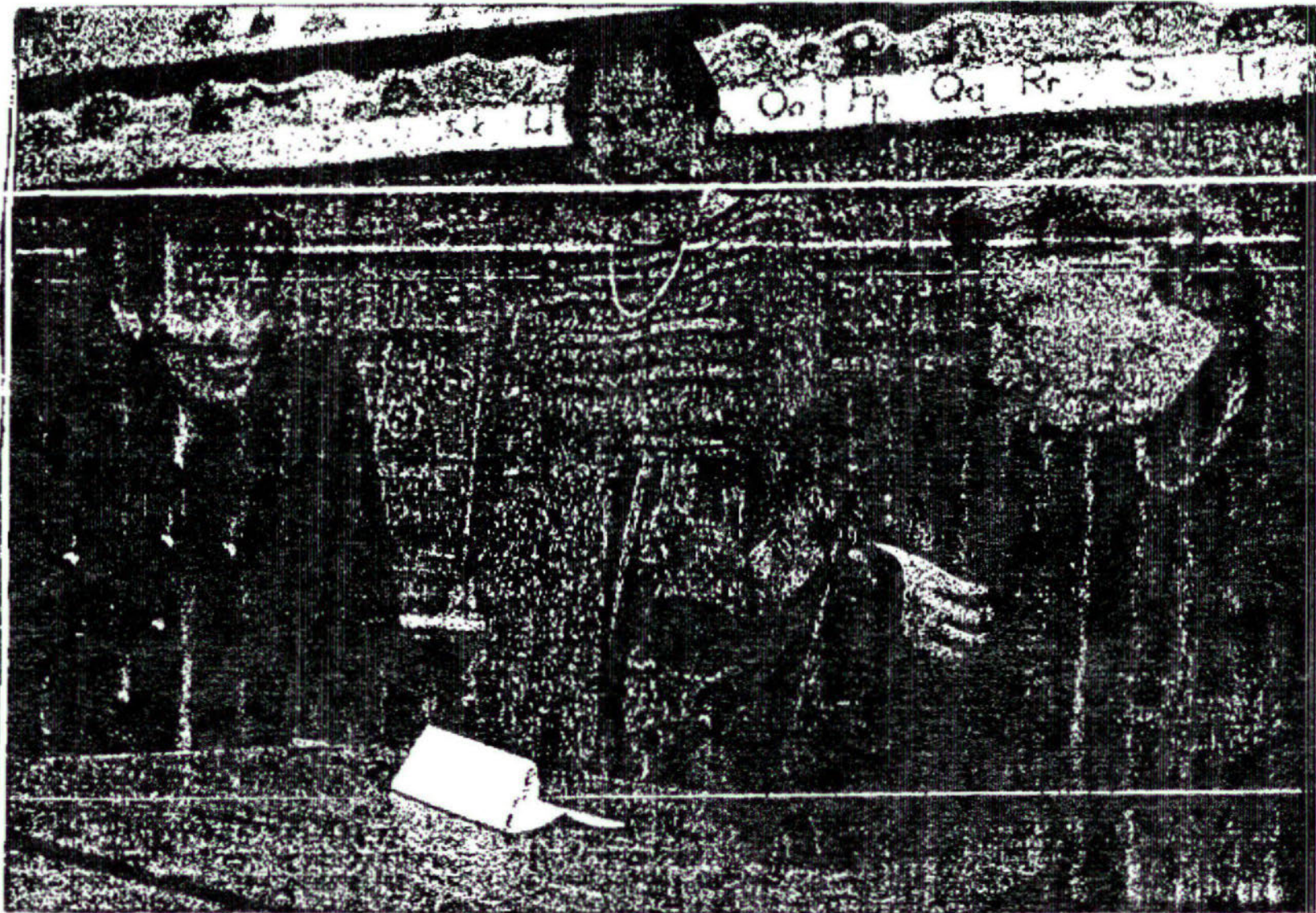
Betances Principal Edna Negron said a clinic at the elementary school level can help to educate children, at a young age, about healthy habits and can prevent health problems that could worsen with age if not treated early.

The clinic, Negron said, may expand its hours in the future to be available to students year-round.

Kennelly, Browner and Dodd said they were impressed by the clinic and stressed the importance of testing students for lead poisoning.

Kennelly has introduced a resolution that states the health care reform basic benefits package should include annual lead screening for children younger than 6.

"Lead is an issue I have cared about for a lot of years," said Browner, who added that the EPA is working for national lead abatement regulations and a way to reduce the high cost of lead paint removal.

thing that only covers catastrophic illnesses.

The insurance also is affordable, Bowles said.

The plan will feature discounts for small businesses as well as allow small businesses to join together in large groups so they will have the same ability to negotiate good, low-cost plans with insurance companies as big businesses have.

Although the picture Bowles painted of the Clinton plan appeared rosy, the audience did not appear willing to buy it.

"Eighty-five percent of Americans are insured and happy with their coverage — 85 percent," said Jim Francis, senior vice president of a real estate agency in Philadelphia. "For 15 percent, you want to dismantle the system."

Bowles agreed 15 percent of Americans are uninsured but said many more are underinsured or overinsured.

Francis also asked that joining the health-care alliances, which will negotiate with insurance providers for plans on behalf of

businesses, be made voluntary.

But Bowles said that would make it take too long for all areas to grow to the size they need to be as powerful in insurance negotiations as big business.

"We can't wait for that to happen," Bowles said. "That's why we need mandatory buying groups."

Joe Silvestri of Upper Gwynedd, owner of Paul Control Technicians of Morrisstown, said he did not believe the Clinton plan would dramatically reduce insurance costs.

"You're here talking about giving more for less and I'm here to say that doesn't work," Silvestri said. "I see government running promises it's not able to keep and we're not going to be able to afford it."

And Arnie Katz, who works for an insurance brokerage, said the Clinton plan does not provide adequately for legal reform that would cut down on medical malpractice cost. He also said he did not believe it would reduce bureaucracy and the resulting administrative costs.

But Bowles said the Clinton

plan does provide for tort reform and for single claim forms, both of which will take costs out of the system.

Both Francis, the Philadelphia businessman, and Mary Price, who owns a small real estate agency in Lower Merion, went into the meeting opposed to the Clinton plan. As a result of it, had their opinions changed?

Francis said, "Are you kidding?"

Price's reply also remained not answered.

"It's mandated medicine," she said.

Price was one of a handful of people at the meeting who waited to see U.S. Rep. Marjorie Margulies-McCarthy, D-PA, after Bowles had left the hall Friday afternoon.

Margulies-McCarthy had set up the meeting but notes that ran late in Washington caused her to miss the train and traffic on the Schuylkill Expressway kept her from getting to the meeting until 3 p.m.

"It was so-o-o-o frustrating," she said of the highway gridlock.

Price told Margulies-McCarthy that for voters.

the Clinton plan was "strictly socialist."

Price asked Margulies-McCarthy how she would vote on it.

"As it stands right now, there is no plan," Margulies-McCarthy said, explaining the Clinton plan would be changed substantially in committee before it would be voted upon. But, "as the plan comes out of the White House, I wouldn't have voted for it."

"But Margie," Price said, "you said you wouldn't vote for the president's (deficit-reduction) plan."

Margulies-McCarthy cast the vote that allowed the plan, which cut spending and raised taxes, to pass in the House. Before the vote she had said she opposed the plan because she believed it should have more spending cuts.

After her ballot was cast, she said she voted for the plan so Clinton could move forward with other critical matters on his agenda and because he agreed to appear at a conference about mandatory spending programs like Medicare and Social Security, which are called entitlements.

Small business speaks its piece

About 15 years ago, Penny's Flowers in Glenside for the first time bought health care insurance for its employees.

The company paid the cost of each worker's insurance and the employees paid the additional coverages for their families.

Now, the company pays only \$30 a month per employee who opts to join the florist's plan while the worker pays the balance, which could be more than \$180 a month, according to managing partner Vincent Pennepacker Jr.

"We have priced [other plans], but other providers — because of the employees' ages — always come back with a higher cost. I have senior citizens working here," Pennepacker said. "It's the best I can come up with. I would like to offer more."

He could do more with President Clinton's health-care reform plan, according to Erskine B. Bowles, administrator of the U.S. Small Business Administration. Bowles touted the plan to area small-business owners in a Glenside meeting Friday.

"The president really tried to concentrate on a program to make sure it would be something that would be helpful to small businesses," Bowles told a group of about 40 businesspeople in Glenside Memorial Hall.

"It's real insurance, comprehensive insurance, insurance that's been offered by Fortune 500 companies. It's not some kind of bare-bones plan or some-

Hispanic business owners meet with head of SBA

Hartford — President Clinton's health plan will help small businesses improve medical benefits for their workers and save money, the head of the U.S. Small Business Administration told a group of Hispanic business owners Monday.

Erskine Bowles, administrator of the SBA, met with about a dozen business owners at a community center in the city's predominantly Hispanic Frog Hollow neighborhood as part of a push by the administration to sell Clinton's health reform package.

He told them Clinton's prescription for cutting the cost of health insurance and providing coverage for everyone would give small

businesses leverage to negotiate lower premiums and better coverage through health care purchasing groups.

"Through market power, this will give you some of the same muscle the big companies have," said Bowles, who was accompanied by U.S. Senator Christopher Dodd, D-Conn., a co-sponsor of the Clinton bill.

The administration is concerned about support from small businesses because several organizations that represent small businesses have been critical of Clinton's health plan. They said it could end up being costly and burdensome for small businesses — especially those that may be forced for the first time to provide insurance for their employees.

But Josefina Clinton, who owns

Hernandez Grocery in Hartford with her husband, Jose, said she is hopeful collective purchasing will lower costs enough for her to afford insurance for her family and six employees, who now rely on hospital emergency rooms for care.

"We're looking for insurance but it's too expensive," she said. "We have hope."

Clinton has submitted a 1,342-page proposal, but has indicated a willingness to compromise on details as congressional committees begin drafting health reform. Hearings are under way.

Bowles also promoted changes underway at the SBA that are designed to make it easier for business owners to apply for government loans. At meetings across the country, Bowles said he heard from business owners who would "rather

throw up than try to borrow money from the SBA" because of red tape and paperwork.

Bowles held up a two-sided single page application for business loans under \$100,000 that should be ready for use April 1. The single sheet will replace a 100-page application book that required backup documents, which some small businesses needed accountants to prepare.

Jerry Zayas, president of the Spanish-American Merchants Association, said the lengthy application and the costs associated with completing it have been an obstacle to business owners seeking loans.

"This is a giant step," said Zayas, who works for Northeast Utilities. "They appear to be trying to simplify the application and that was one of the difficulties."

Zayas praised Bowles for making the trip, saying it was the first visit from an SBA official to the area.

Dodd, SBA chief on visit supporting Clinton health plan

NEW BRITAIN — U.S. Sen. Christopher Dodd, D-Conn. and Small Business Administration Chief Erskine Bowles told local small-business owners this morning that President Clinton's universal health care proposal will eventually help them obtain comprehensive coverage at lower costs for their employees.

Bowles, a veteran investment banker and now President Clinton's health care advocate, tried to quell popular concerns of nearly 50 local entrepreneurs that sweeping changes in the nation's health-care infrastructure would force them to foot the bill.

Speaking at Central Connecticut State University, the two fielded questions and suggestions from small-business leaders in an effort they say will help the president and Washington lawmakers draft health care legislation that could appear in Congress sometime this fall.

"I take the position of supporting the president's proposal, and its universal nature. If you want to achieve affordability and reform, you have to have universality," said Sen. Dodd.

About 92 percent of Connecticut residents have some sort of health insurance, and 71 percent of small-business owners provide their employees coverage, according to Sen. Dodd. Still, 24,000 residents lose health insurance every month and join the nation's 38.5 million without coverage.

Bowles said that small businesses will benefit from health-care reform by cutting costs, even though some owners see themselves as targeted to pay more for their employees under the new plan.

"At present the rate of increase for small businesses is about 50 percent higher than large ones, and that is for insurance that really isn't that comprehensive. I've always believed in the private sector solving its own problems, but in this case I believe we've failed," Bowles said.

The SBA chief said large buying groups formed by small business consortiums will take power away from health-care providers and allow them to demand better service. Holding down workers' compensation costs and the overall rate of growth of health insurance will stop health-care prices from increasing at the current 15 percent a year, he said.

"This plan will give the small-business owner that market muscle so we can keep costs down. It also gives the employee a choice of multiple providers and plans. Don't listen to the rhetoric; listen to reality," said Bowles.

But some business owners said they were angry at what they see as an increased burden on the hard-working middle class to pay for society's ills. In Connecticut, Bowles said an average working family's health-care costs have risen 114 percent faster than its wages, a statistic some audience members said pointed to a greater problem.

"Small business owners are afraid of the new plan. They know government is bankrupt, and a tremendous debt in society has created a large welfare base. The have-nots are expecting the entrepreneurs to pay their bills," said John Keating, owner of a Hartford-based construction firm.

"People are looking to the government for a pill that will make them live forever. You see them all along Park Street (in Hartford), and they're expecting hospitals to make them better. I'm angry we have to pay," Keating said.

Sen. Dodd said that under the president's new plan, universal coverage would not entice people to stay out of work and on welfare, a move that would cut costs. In Connecticut 84 percent of people without health care are employed, he said.

"You'd be a fool to get off welfare because you get health care. We have to scrap that whole idea," Sen. Dodd said.

Dick Burcaw, owner of a money-management firm, asked why small businesses would not get the same tax deductions as larger ones in paying for employee insurance plans.

"I find it cynical that you think you can change the system with one stroke of the pen. Why don't you start with the tax code and change it? The small businessman doesn't get any deductions for his insurance," said Burcaw.

Others suggested taking the best aspects to the nation's present health care system and refining them, instead of forcing Americans to accept an entirely new plan.

"Why don't we recognize the social problems that have created higher costs? It seems like we're trying to solve issues like malpractice without taking advantage of what our present system has to offer," said Don Whitmore, chief financial officer for a local company.

Firms may soon get simpler loan forms

SBA official, Dodd visit Park Street

Lively Caribbean music and the aroma of roasted chicken filled an indoor marketplace Monday as Park Street merchants in Hartford earnestly explained the problems of getting loans and affording health care to a U.S. senator and a federal business czar.

Sen. Christopher J. Dodd and Erskine B. Bowles, head of the Small Business Administration, visited El Mercado, an indoor marketplace where stock at various stalls includes everything from plantains, yucca and fresh cuts of pork to jewelry and music.

The officials then sat down with owners of small businesses at Mi Casa, a social center down the street.

Bernard Diego, president of Peerless Travel Services on Park Street, said it can cost a businessperson more than \$10,000 to get through the red tape for a \$100,000 government loan.

Although Diego wasn't talking about a Small Business Administration loan, Bowles acknowledged his

agency's application process has included wasteful and unnecessary information-gathering.

Holding up his agency's inch-thick application, Bowles said it will be replaced this spring by the two-page form he held in his other hand, for most loans of as much as \$100,000.

The Small Business Administration, he said, is trying to make its programs more "user-friendly" by such simplification and by placing more of its staff at the district level instead of in Washington, D.C., or regional offices.

One local businessman complained that banks don't want to make very small loans. Bowles agreed, saying that because of processing and servicing costs in a loan, banks prefer to deal with big borrowers instead of many small ones.

The agency's "micro-loan" program — loans of as much as \$25,000 — has been expanding to include more lenders, Bowles said.

Also, the agency is exploring whether it can link up with a local economic development corporation

to make it more attractive for banks to make small loans, said Jo-Ann Van Vechten, the agency's district director. If certified by the Small Business Administration, the corporation would underwrite and package applications for small loans for certain banks, and the agency would guarantee the loans.

Carlos M. Lopez of Luis of Hartford Inc., a furniture store, said of Monday's visit: "It was very refreshing to see people come down to see small business people down on the ladder."

"For years, people have been saying small business is the backbone of this country, but they're behind the eight-ball," Lopez said.

Lopez says he's taking a wait-and-see attitude on whether the current administration will make things better for area merchants. "We've heard the same promises before."

Getting capital to small businesses so that they can create jobs is a better long-term solution to crime than any anti-crime bill Congress can design, said Dodd, D-Conn.

"A kid you offer a job to is a kid that's less likely to end up with a revolver in his hand or standing before a juvenile judge in this town," Dodd said. "This is not only good for business, good for the economy; this is the best answer to solving our crime problem."

Several business people during the Park Street visit — and many at a forum earlier in the morning in New Britain — asked whether health care reform will help or burden them.

Bowles defended President Clinton's reform plan against criticism that it will create bureaucratic purchasing alliances for employers. The proposed alliances, he said, would "take all of us in this room and put us together with thousands of other small businesses and give us some marketpower, some of that same muscle that big business has."

Dodd, a co-sponsor of the Clinton bill, believes his assurances may have helped a little to assuage business people's concerns voiced at a forum Monday at Central Connecticut State University in New Britain.

"People are inclined to be afraid of anything government does," Dodd said. "That's a mountain to climb; there's no question about it."

Outlined below is a brief summary of last week's health care events. Just this weekend I moved into the war room and took over what surrogate scheduling efforts were underway. We are now focussed exclusively on Congressional targets and creating regional media events. During next week's Congressional recess Cabinet Secretaries and other surrogates will be traveling to targeted states in support of the "Seniors" theme. Attached are press clips and a draft of next week's schedule.

I. CABINET-MEMBER EVENTS

- o **Roger Altman - Brewster:** Traveled to Oklahoma and addressed a business luncheon sponsored by Kerr-McGee Corporation and a business town hall meeting sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce. A summary is of the meeting is attached.
- o **Dr. Phil Lee - Rep. Strickland:** Spoke at a town hall meeting given by Rep. Ted Strickland on February 4, 1994 in Portsmouth, Ohio.
- o **Judy Feder - Nita Lowey:** Represented the administration on panels at three town hall meetings for Rep. Nita Lowey in New York on February 6, 1994.

II. CABINET MESSAGE EVENTS
