From 2-6 October 1995, the International Union of Bricklayers and Allied Craftsmen (BAC) will hold its 1995 IU Convention at the Palmer House Hotel in Chicago, Illinois. On behalf of the IU Executive Board, it is my pleasure to invite you to join us as the Convention's keynote speaker on the morning of Monday, 2 October.

Founded 130 years ago, BAC is the oldest construction union in North America. We are proud to represent the 95,000 organized masonry workers in the United States and Canada. In the tradition of that rich and abiding heritage, BAC has been in the vanguard of developing innovative labor-management programs designed to train a highly skilled, productive workforce, capable of meeting the growing demands of our signatory contractors and the masonry industry now and in the future.

As an industry, we must grow to survive. The same is true for our Union. In order to recruit and retain more workers into our ranks, the International Union has undertaken an ambitious member education program, geared toward generating more discussion among rank and file members on pressing union and government policy issues that affect us most. Topics such as trade jurisdiction, organizing, retaining younger members, and the array of hostile, anti-worker measures before Congress, including efforts to repeal Davis-Bacon, the TEAM Act, and the Administration's critical support of workers' rights, are routinely discussed by our members every month in small groups known as Chapter Meetings. We're finding that a return to this kind of meaningful discussion, the cornerstone of trade unionism, has been invaluable in increasing the flow of communication between members and all levels of Union leadership.

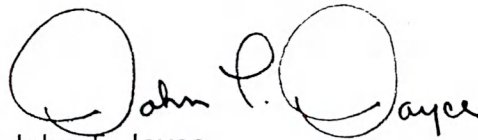
