Two items.

1. Attendance

As you requested, attached is a list of those Tribal Chairs who have been invited to the April 7 meeting with the President.

This invitation was extended to elected Tribal Chairs ONLY.

*All have indicated they will attend.

2. Format

I think we should keep this informal and informative.

Maximum time: 30-45 minutes.

Here's what I suggest.

- (1) POTUS arrives, guests seated at conference table.
- (2) Tribal leaders introduce themselves, by name and tribe and area of state.
- (3) One or two Chairs, selected by members, thank POTUS for all he's done for Indians nationally and briefly speak about their activities and interests in California.
- (4) POTUS responds briefly.
- (5) Questions and open discussion.

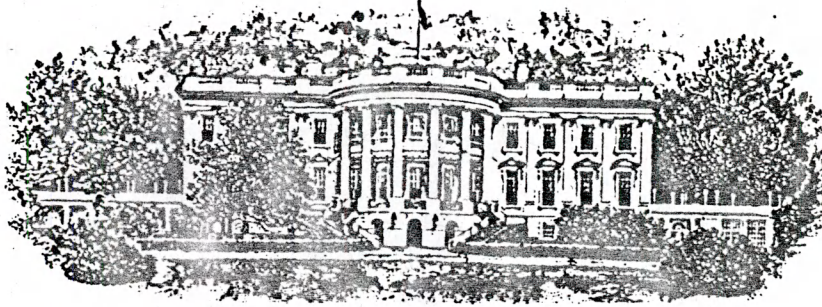
