Historic settings including the Lincoln Memorial, the Washington Monument, the White House, the U.S. Capitol, and the Smithsonian Institution will frame a spectacular celebration that will ring out the old millennium and ring in 2000 on the National Mall in Washington, D.C. *America's Millennium* will be an exciting and historic celebration for the nation, a patriotic and family-friendly event in the Nation's Capital. Thousands of visitors will attend the free events, and hundreds of millions will watch portions of it on worldwide television.

AMERICA'S MILLENNIUM GALA
Quincy Jones and George Stevens, Jr., will produce a stirring show that will build toward an unforgettable *Midnight Moment* to mark the time we pass into the new century and new millennium. The audience, expected to number in the hundreds of thousands, will gather on the Mall. Great stars of the entertainment world will perform with a 100-piece orchestra, along with the combined bands, choirs, and marching units of the U.S. Armed Forces. The entertainment will center on the great American music of the century, choreographed to celebrate the ennobling achievements of our country — summing up in song and memory that which has made the United States a great nation.

THE UNFINISHED JOURNEY

Steven Spielberg will create a seventeen-minute motion picture expressing the highlights of the 20th century. John Williams will compose an original score that will be conducted with the orchestra as the film is projected on huge outdoor screens. The Spielberg film will have its world premiere simultaneously at the Lincoln Memorial and on the worldwide telecast in the half-hour leading up to midnight.

MILLENNIUM AROUND THE WORLD

The Ronald Reagan International Trade Center will be the site of a worldwide broadcast feed following millennium celebrations and events around the world.

MIDNIGHT MOMENT

The *Midnight Moment* will be a spectacular high-tech sound and light display between the Lincoln Memorial and the Washington Monument that will be the nation's salute to the new century. Citizens from across the nation will be able to come together and share this extraordinary moment in history live on television. It will conclude with American children — joined by the stars of the gala, choruses, and the hundreds of thousands of celebrants on the Mall — raising their voices in a rousing sing-along to lift our hearts in the first hour of the new millennium.

MAIN STREET MILLENNIUM

The City of Washington, D.C., will hold a Constitution Avenue block party featuring a diversity of local and regional entertainment and culinary fare.

MILLENNIUM ON THE MALL: TRADITIONS AND TOMORROWS

The Smithsonian will present an array of exhibitions highlighting the history and culture of the nation and the world. Over the course of the three-day weekend, family-oriented special performances, lectures, and demonstrations will examine the worlds of music, art, literature, sports, science, and technology illustrating past accomplishments and future visions along the Mall. Among the highlights — a digital time capsule that will enable visitors to pass along thoughts to future generations.
