Public Deliverables

USDA

- **Signing of the Empowerment Community Award.** USDA has designated an Empowerment Community on the Navajo Nation. The signing ceremony for the Empowerment Community could occur during the President's visit. Navajo Nation President Kelsey Begaye would participate in the ceremony. maybe \$2 million. **USDA looking to add something more.**

Interior has already produced a CD-ROM on "Doing Business in Indian Country" and this CD-ROM could be distributed to non-tribal businesses.
