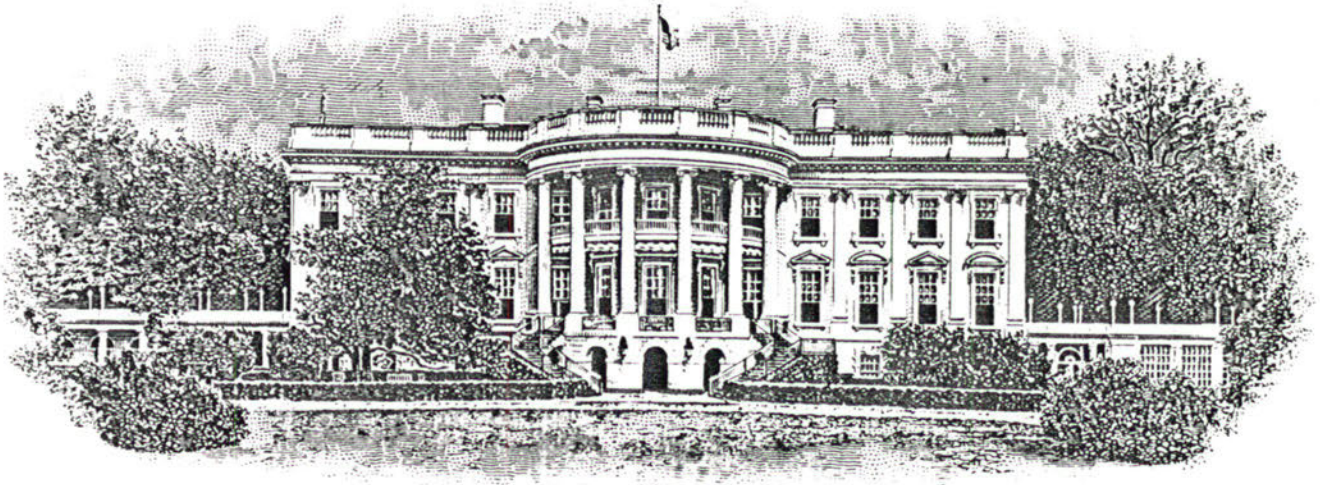

SUBJECT: ASSIGNMENT OF SERVICEMARK -- NEEDED FOR BILL SIGNING

I spoke this morning with Bernie; the President has approved the name "Americorps" for the new national service participants, and the name is scheduled to be unveiled in connection with the signing of the legislation (in turn, expected to be on September 13).

We ran a trademark search and came up with the attached registration. I have negotiated with its owner, who has agreed to assign the mark. Attached you will find a letter agreement and Assignment of Servicemark to accomplish this. Bernie asked for you to review this and give us your comments today (we then need to do logo development and take a whole series of other steps before the 13th).

I flag the following for you:

1. The assignee is problematical. The Corporation for National Service will not exist until October 1, and is further predicated on final Senate passage of the Conference Report on the Bill (expected next Tuesday or Wednesday). The attached reflect my proposed solution, which Bernie liked: Eli acts as trustee for the to-be-formed Corporation, and the right to assignment is stated.
2. The assignor has a media plan associated with the name. We have not seen this, nor discussed its contents, and are not seeking its assignment.
3. I do not know applicable law regarding consideration; I have inserted the standard verbiage about acknowledged adequacy, which would be sufficient in California, but I do not know if it does the trick here.

Re: Assignment of Servicemark

Dear Jerry:

This letter will reflect the agreement between The Wishnow Group, Inc., a Massachusetts corporation ("TWG") and Eli Segal, as trustee for the Corporation for National Service, a to-be created government corporation established by the National and Community Service Trust Act of 1993 ("CNS") with respect to the mark "AMERICORPS" (the "Mark"), which is represented by U.S. Patent and Trademark Reg. No. 1,309,313 and is owned by TWG (the "Registration").

In consideration for the promises contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, TWG and CNS hereby agree as follows:

1. TWG agrees to execute the attached Assignment of Servicemark, and any and all other documents reasonably necessary to cause the transfer of all right, title and interest in and to the Mark from TWG to CNS.
2. TWG represents and warrants that it has good and clear title to the Mark; that it is aware of no impediments to its title or its ability to transfer it hereunder; and that it has taken all steps necessary to protect and maintain the validity of the Registration.
3. In the event that CNS is not established as a matter of law prior to December 31, 1993, then Mr. Segal as trustee shall have the right to transfer, assign and set over all right, title and interest in and to the Mark to such other agency, department, corporation, commission or similar instrumentality of the government of the United States of America as may be designated by the President of the United States, and TWG agrees to execute any and all documents reasonably necessary to accomplish the same.

4. CNS acknowledges that TWG is hereby transferring only its interest in the Mark, and CNS acknowledges that it does not have (nor is it hereby acquiring) any right to nor interest in any program for business advantage, including any media plan, developed by TWG or Mr. Jerry Wishnow and formerly identified by or with the Mark. *Jerry Wishnow*

5. This *←* Jerry, I am gratified by your public spiritedness and willingness to consent to this assignment, and look forward to working with you on national service in the months ahead. In the event that this letter (together with the Assignment of Servicemark which is attached) reflects our understanding, kindly execute both of them (and have the Assignment of Servicemark notarized) and return them to me via the Federal Express envelope provided for that purpose, whereupon it shall represent the agreement of CNS and TWG, binding upon them and their respective successors and assigns.
