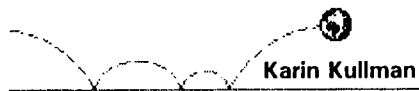

Interns take a hands-on approach to the often complicated and time-sensitive processes behind the issuing of Presidential statements. Over a semester, they gain an intimate perspective on White House activities, with students and future policy-makers stepping beyond American politics textbooks into the sometimes difficult, but always fascinating, real world of high-level decision making.

Speechwriting interns must be able to perform well under pressure in the fast-paced environment of the Executive Branch. With a focus on research and office tasks, research and writing skills are of the utmost importance. A journalistic or editorial background is often beneficial.
