Dear Melanne:

Thank you so much for talking with me on Monday regarding First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton's participation in the American Council on Education's WOMEN PRESIDENTS' SUMMIT III to be held at Mills College, June 13-15, 1996. We are just delighted that you all are willing for her to prepare a video presentation to the SUMMIT, since she is not able to attend in person.

Enclosed is a preliminary copy of the program so that you can see how we have currently billed the video and where it fits in the program. **The goals** of the SUMMIT are to enhance the knowledge base of the women presidents about the United Nations Platform for Action that resulted from the Fourth World Conference on Women; to give the presidents an opportunity to interact with one another; to inspire them to speak out on behalf of women at all levels of society; and to make clear—to quote the First Lady—"that human rights are women's rights and women's rights are human rights," and that global, national and local agendas are women's agendas and visa versa.

The audience for the SUMMIT is composed largely of women college and university presidents, rectors and vice chancellors from around the world. Of the nearly 450 women presidents from the U.S., we expect over 100 to attend, and we will have around 20 women rectors and vice chancellors from South Africa, Japan, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Finland, Norway, Egypt, India, the Philippines, Brazil, the Bahamas and Slovina.

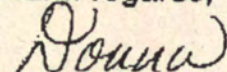

THIRD WOMEN PRESIDENTS' SUMMIT TO CONVENE JUNE 13-15 IN CALIFORNIA

Washington, DC (May 28, 1996)—Women leaders of colleges and universities in the U.S. and from other nations will meet June 13-15 at Mills College in Oakland, CA, to devise strategies to influence policy on national and international issues, explore ideas on how to shape the future, and discuss ways to improve the conditions of women worldwide.

The Women Presidents' Summit, the third such gathering sponsored by the American Council on Education (ACE), will bring together several hundred current and recent women leaders of accredited U.S. colleges and universities, as well as women rectors and vice chancellors of higher education institutions in other countries. Previous summits were held in Washington, DC in 1990 and 1993.

"Women are more prominent in decision-making positions in politics, business, and the independent sector, as well as in higher education; they have proven themselves as leaders and taken critical stands on behalf of other women," said Donna Shavlik, director of ACE's Office of Women in Higher Education, which is organizing the event. "Yet the visibility of women in the public domain has not meant that the power of our voices has become manifest in the fundamental organizing principles of our society, or in the setting of our institutional, national, and global agendas."

This summit, Shavlik added, "will focus on increasing women's voices and, we hope, inspire women presidents to speak forcefully about the critical issues society faces as we move into the 21st century."

During the meeting, participants will discuss possible revisions, clarifications, and additions to an earlier report, **A Blueprint for Leadership: How Women College and University Presidents Can Shape the Future**. That document was produced following the previous summit in 1993.

In addition, the presidents will discuss ways to promote the "Platform for Action" agenda adopted at the 1995 United Nations Fourth World Conference on Women, held in Beijing, China, last September. The platform lists 12 obstacles that hamper women's advancement throughout the world and recommends actions needed to improve the condition of women.

This summit also marks the first official meeting of the **International Network of Women College and University Presidents, Rectors, and Vice Chancellors**, which was formed prior to the Beijing conference to "connect women presidents around the world" and encourage their leadership on women's issues.

Guest speakers during the event will include Angela Glover Blackwell, vice president of the Rockefeller Foundation, who will discuss challenges faced by women leaders, and Judith A. Sturnick, executive director of the Bay Area office of the Community Excellence Institute, who will explore the personal and spiritual dimensions of leadership.

Linda Tarr-Whalen, U.S. Representative to the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women, will deliver the closing address. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton will appear on video and offer summit participants her perspectives on women leaders' responsibilities to speak out on women's issues.

The summit also will feature a gala tribute to women's leadership through the arts, with a special performance by internationally known singer and entertainer Shirley Mae Springer Staten.

Nearly 200 women higher education leaders, including nearly half of all U.S. women college and university presidents and 20 of the more than 400 women rectors abroad, attended the 1993 summit. Currently, more than 470 women head colleges and universities in the U.S., and about 400 serve as rectors and in other top positions in other nations.

That meeting was held in New York City in March of 1995 preceding the 39th Session of the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women which was convening to prepare for the 1995 conference in Beijing. There was unanimous agreement among the 15 women who attended that there should be such a network. The express purposes of the network are to connect women presidents around the world, to encourage their leadership on issues of concern to all women, and to promote

As you will note from the enclosed publication, *Compass*, the first expression of the need for leadership by women in higher education is to promote the "Critical Areas of Concern" presented in the **UN Platform for Action**. Also included in the publication is information on how to become part of the newly established network, **The International Network of Women College and University Presidents, Rectors, and Vice Chancellors**.

The third WOMEN PRESIDENTS' SUMMIT at Mills College will be the first official meeting of the **International Network**, so we are eager to have as many women higher education leaders from all regions of the world as possible. We have identified more than 370 women who are heads of colleges and universities in 52 countries. Our goal is to have at least 50 of those women participate in the SUMMIT. **We hope that you will be one of them.**

The SUMMIT begins at 1:00 p.m. on June 13, 1996, and ends at 2:30 p.m. on June 15. The official language of the SUMMIT will be English. We have asked the U.S. college and university presidents who will attend if they wish to invite international guests to visit their campuses for two or three days immediately before or after the SUMMIT. Please let us know immediately of your interest in visiting a campus. You may respond on the enclosed questionnaire.

Although we would like to financially support women who come from countries where it is difficult to obtain hard currency, limited funds make it impossible for ACE to cover travel, per diem and registration costs. We have sought outside help for that purpose. We have written or spoken to representatives of the World Bank, the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID), the U.S. Information Agency ("USIS" abroad), and several foundations and businesses in the U.S. with international operations. All or some of those organizations may have offices in your country, and you may wish to contact them directly. (USAID and USIS may be reached through the American Embassy.)

If your institution is unable to pay for you to attend the SUMMIT, use the list above to contact the appropriate person in your country who might be able to offer you financial assistance. This letter of invitation can serve as an explanation of the SUMMIT to funders. In discussing your interest in attending the SUMMIT with potential funders, we suggest you mention the possibility of a before or after campus visit. We believe many of the funders will consider this a special opportunity, and be more interested in supporting your participation in the SUMMIT.

The 1996 SUMMIT is eagerly anticipated by the U.S. presidents as well as the founders of the **International Network** who will attend. Your presence and contribution would greatly enhance the success and significance of the SUMMIT. We sincerely hope you will join us in this important work.

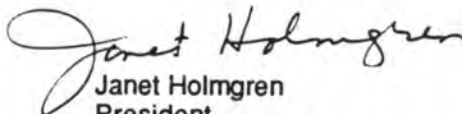

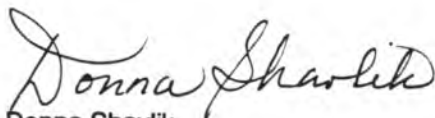

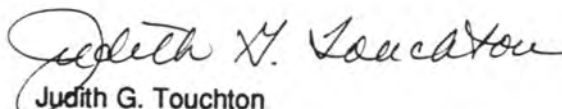

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INTRODUCTION

The Office of Women in Higher Education of the American Council on Education compiled this list of women college and university presidents and chief executive officers using the following criteria:

- In defining CEOs, the most typical titles are president and chancellor, but persons who function as CEOs—and are considered by their peers—sometimes have the title of provost, campus executive officer, or campus dean. Such exceptions usually occur within community college systems.
- CEO's listed are in institutions which are regionally accredited, degree-granting institutions, i.e., MSA/CHE, NEASC-CIHE, NCA, NASC, SACS-Commission of Colleges, WASC-Sr., and WASC-Jr., in the U.S. and outlying areas (e.g., Puerto Rico).
- CEO's also may be head of a college or university system, state commission or state department of higher education.

The major sources used in the preparation of this listing are the American Council on Education Presidential Database, and information and files of the Office of Women in Higher Education. **Please include attribution to OWHE/ACE if you reproduce all or part of this compilation.**

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The Office of Women in Higher Education of the American Council on Education compiled this list of women heads of colleges and universities abroad for the purpose of inviting them to the third **Women Presidents' Summit** to be held in Oakland, California, June 13-15, 1996.

Where we were unable to obtain the names of individuals, we listed only titles and institutions because we know that women hold the positions. We also included deans of university departments when, to our knowledge, there were no women rectors, chancellors, vice chancellors, or directors in that particular country.

This list was compiled for the Office of Women in Higher Education of the American Council on Education by Mary P. Haney, Haney Associates, Washington, DC, with the assistance of Missy Freeman. Information was provided by foreign embassies in the United States and ministries of education abroad. 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Women Higher Education Leaders Embark on Path to Global Leadership

For two days in March, a representative group of 15 women higher education leaders from 12 countries met in New York to discuss how women around the world can expand their influence on public policies that affect them. • The seminar was sponsored by the Office of Women in Higher Education (OWHE) of the American Council on Education (ACE) and was scheduled to coincide with the meeting of the United Nations (UN) Commission on the Status of Women and the Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) Consultation. • Both of those events were being held to prepare for the Fourth UN World Conference on Women and NGO Forum '95, to be held in China in late August and early September. •

At the ACE seminar, participants created the International Network of Women College and University Presidents, Rectors, and Vice Chancellors; proposed a series of educational activities that they and their counterparts could undertake to raise consciousness and have an impact on policy decisions affecting women around the world; and planned a workshop for the NGO Consultation, "Women in Higher Education: A Role in Global Leadership." This workshop also will be presented at the NGO Forum.

Following is a summary of the events leading up to and the results of the New

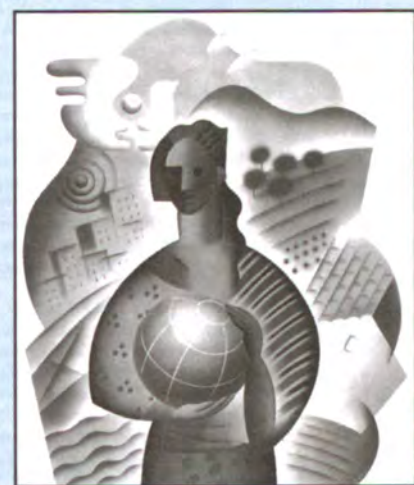
