Attached are the facts of life on Camp David. It is not going to be easy. There are lodges for the President, Barak, and Arafat. There are a total of 40 other beds. 25 of these are in cabins, sleeping one, two, three or four people. Fifteen of the sleeping places are in a barracks, with all the rooms, except one, having two beds.

Assuming that this means principal plus 13 for each delegation, we are going to face some hard choices. A rough guess at the minimum number of people who will be needed:

Academcy, which located near Camp David.
Another option, would be to bring trailers into
Camp David.

I would see Camp David, much like a foreign trip
site.

- The Advance Office, working with NSC, would have overall responsibility for coordinating what happens at the site.
- The Mil Office, which runs Camp David, would have operational responsibiity for providing support to those at Camp David.

The State Department and Protocol would be responsible for setting up and running the FEMA facility, and for taking care of the Israeli and Palestinian delegations, when they are not at Camp David.
