RE: Crisis management

You asked for a summary of Deputies Committee and Principals Committee meetings, including the number of times they have met on Somalia, Haiti and Bosnia. Since the inauguration, the Principals Committee has met 38 times; the Deputies Committee has met 60 times. On these three crises alone, the PC has met 23 times; the DC 30 times.

Bosnia -- between February 2 and October 2, the Principals Committee met 18 times. Between February 8 and July 26, the Deputies Committee met 12 times.

Haiti -- between April 13 and October 19, the Principals Committee met 4 times. Between January 23 and September 11, the Deputies Committee met 5 times.

Somalia -- the Principals Committee has not held a formal meeting on Somalia. However, the majority of the Principals met with the President on October 5 and 6. He also signed a Presidential Directive relating to Somalia policy (attached) on May 19th. The Directive was then sent to most of the Principals, among others. Between January 25 and September 30, the Deputies Committee met 9 times.

Presidential involvement in Somalia

In addition to the regular morning briefings with the National Security Advisor, the Deputy National Security Advisor and the Vice President, the President received a total of 75 memos on Somalia. While many of these were Congressional, heads of state and other correspondence, a number of them updated the President on Somalia policy. Below is a summary of fifteen memos the President saw and/or signed that relate to Somalia policy.
