Please pass to Nancy:

I have talked with Tom Ramsey (Acting CG in Belfast) and Larry Robinson (from Embassy London, who will be in Belfast to assist your visit and attend the conference) about meetings, etc in Belfast as we discussed yesterday. They have the following suggestions and questions to which they would like your reaction ASAP:

-- They are setting up a meeting with the UUP on Tuesday afternoon. Not sure whether Molyneaux can attend, but unlikely since it's the first full Parliamentary day after Whitsun recess and he may be in London.

-- Drinks at the residence on Tuesday evening won't work as there's no staff there and logistics would be tricky. (Obviously, though, if a few of us want to gather there informally that's a possibility -- if we go out and get our own drinks) Suggested alternative is to invite one or two each from SDLP and Sinn Fein to drinks at the Europa or nearby bar an hour or so before the dinner.

-- ConGen Belfast is holding a reservation at the Europa for you. Do you need it, or have you already made arrangements?

-- USIS is standing by to arrange one or more press events -- most likely a lunch with editors -- if you decide to do this. They are pressing for a quick decision.

-- In addition to the UUP meeting Tuesday afternoon, suggestions from Belfast and London for other meetings are: a program at Stormont including a courtesy call on a minister or David Fell, someone from NIO and perhaps RUC and/or Army. Possible alternatives would be a meeting or 2 with other parties, or a car tour of Belfast. What are your preferences?

It was good of you to see me yesterday in your weakened state. I hope that by the time you receive this you will be fully recovered.

On behalf of Lord Carrington and the Steering Committee, it is my pleasure to invite you to the 1995 Bilderberg Meeting which will take place June 8-11 in Burgenstock, Switzerland. It will begin with dinner on Thursday, June 8th, and conclude after lunch on Sunday, June 11.

As you may know, Bilderberg was started some 30 years ago to bring together prominent Europeans and Americans to consider serious issues affecting the Atlantic Community, with a view to strengthening relationships and encouraging common purpose and action. We have about 100 leaders and experts at the annual conference from 16 or more countries, including Prime Ministers, Foreign and Defense Ministers, CEO's, and other outstanding individuals.

Of the many conferences that take place around the world, Bilderberg remains the most focused effort to strengthen U.S.-European ties. It is particularly significant given the end of the cold war and the need for the West to work for a new, successful relationship with the Eastern countries and to deal in united strength with the growing number of challenges in other parts of the world.

I would very much like to have you join us in Burgenstock and am confident you would find it rewarding. Please let me know if there is more I can do to persuade you to accept. You can reach me at Georgetown at 202-687-6279.

Dear Ms. Soderberg:

USIA looks forward to facilitating your plans to travel to Belfast in early June. We understand that the primary purpose of your visit is to attend the conference on conflict resolution organized by the Foundation for a Civil Society Project on Justice in Times of Transition. As you may know, USIA is providing a grant of \$10,000 to the conference to pay for the travel of six participants from the U.S. Since we are already providing a grant for attendees to the conference, we regret that we are unable to fund your airfare in addition to this grant.

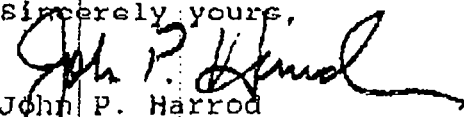
If, however, you are able to spend a couple of additional days in Northern Ireland, USIA would be pleased to organize a program of public contacts to forward USG objectives. USIS London would arrange a schedule of meetings with prominent opinion leaders in Belfast, for you to discuss, formally or informally, U.S. policy in Northern Ireland; working with you to decide on the specific topics of the program and the interlocutors from politics, academia, economics and the media who would be invited to attend.

Among the possibilities for such a program would be a luncheon discussion with editors and owners of major media. Such an event would provide high-level contact with the media and would facilitate a more substantive exchange than is perhaps reflected in the day-to-day sensationalist news coverage. If you are able to stay for such contacts, USIA would of course pay for your per diem for those program days.

Even if you plan only to attend the conference, our field officers inform us that your visit will undoubtedly elicit wide media interest. They are ready to assist you with your media availability in whatever way you feel would be most effective.

USIA looks forward to discussing these opportunities in more detail with you.
