IRISH PRIME MINISTER BRUTON
March 17, 1995

10:10 a.m. Prime Minister Bruton and party arrive at the West Lobby and are greeted by the Chief of Protocol, Mollie Raiser, who will escort the Prime Minister to the Cabinet Room to sign the guest book.

10:15 a.m. The Chief of Protocol escorts the Prime Minister into the Oval Office, via the hallway entrance and makes introductions. White House Photographers/TV enter the Oval for brief photos (2 minutes).

10:17 a.m. Meeting begins.

10:32 a.m. Meeting ends. The President and Prime Minister Bruton remain in the Oval Office. Other meeting participants are escorted into the Roosevelt Room.

10:34 a.m. The President escorts the Prime Minister into the Roosevelt Room. (The President stands to the left of the Podium, Prime Minister Reynolds in front of the Podium.)

10:35 a.m. Prime Minister Bruton presents the President with the traditional bowl of Shamrocks.

10:37 a.m. The President accepts the Shamrocks and Press Availability begins.

10:43 a.m. Press Availability ends. President shakes hands with guests on the front row.

10:45 a.m. The President and Prime Minister Bruton exit the Roosevelt Room to the Oval, where they hold briefly (allowing time for the remaining Irish Delegation to board their vehicles on the South Lawn).

10:47 a.m. The President bids farewell to the Prime Minister on the porch, outside the Oval Office.

10:48 a.m.

The Prime Minister is escorted to his motorcade
and departs the White House grounds.
