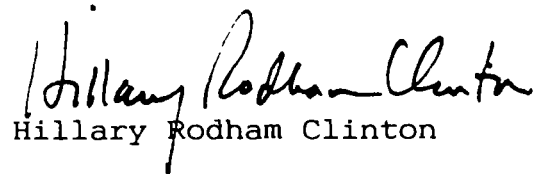
Dear Senator Glenn:

Thank you for forwarding the letter from your consitituent, Ronald L. Webster, Ph.D., Director of the Hollins Communications Research Institute.

Under the President's proposal for health care reform, states are responsible for establishing and publishing criteria for certification of health plans to ensure that they provide high quality care and have the capacity to deliver all of the services in the comprehensive benefit package. States may also require that one or more certified health plans provide their enrollees with access to centers of excellence. Under the President's plan, centers of excellence will be defined by the states but are intended to include specialty institutions.

I look forward to working with you in the coming weeks as Congress works toward passage of health care reform legislation.
