Thank you for writing about health care reform and the pressing need to reduce waste in the Medicare system.

Medicare has been very successful in giving older Americans the health care security they deserve. Therefore, the health care reform bills introduced by Senator Mitchell and Congressman Gephardt preserve and improve Medicare by adding coverage for prescription drugs and create a new long-term care program for elderly and disabled Americans.

At the same time, skyrocketing Medicare costs must be slowed. This can be accomplished, in large part, by eliminating much of the waste, fraud and abuse in our current Medicare system. Cases such as yours, (b)(6)
