Dear Congressman Rahall:

Thank you for your letter concerning your constituent, [REDACTED] (b)(6) [REDACTED]. No American should be forced to choose between health care coverage and food or other needs, [REDACTED] (b)(6) [REDACTED].

Rising health care costs have been a growing problem for American families. While we continue to pay more for health care, Americans are getting less and less of the care they need. Families postpone getting preventive health care because they cannot afford insurance. Many are forced to seek care only at emergency rooms when their illnesses become serious and costly.

The President's proposal for health care reform gives Americans the security they deserve. The plan will guarantee every American private health insurance coverage that can never be taken away. It will be illegal for insurance companies to drop coverage or cut benefits, charge higher premiums based on health condition, or apply lifetime limits on coverage.

The President's plan will also make health care affordable for American families. Health plans will compete for
