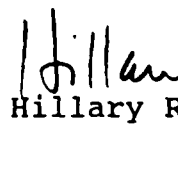
Dear Congressman Wise:

At the same time, an overwhelming majority of the American people continue to support universal coverage -- 78% according to a recent ABC News/Washington Post Poll.
