SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR FISCAL DATA FOR VISIT OF FIRST LADY

1. POST IS PREPARING FOR THE FIRST LADY'S PRE-ADVANCE, ARRIVING ON JUNE 4. WE ANTICIPATE INCURRING COSTS FOR INTERPRETERS, TRANSPORTATION, TELEPHONE CALLS, AS OUTLINED BELOW, FOR THE ADVANCE. WE HAVE ALSO INCLUDED SOME CHARGES WE CAN ANTICIPATE FOR THE OTHER PORTIONS OF THE VISIT. WE UNDERSTAND THE PRE-ADVANCE PARTY WILL PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION ON FISCAL MATTERS, BUT THAT MANY OF THE FOLLOWING COSTS ARE "BUREAU REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES." WE ARE THEREFORE PROVIDING THE FOLLOWING FOR YOUR REVIEW AND COMMENT. POST ALSO REQUESTS AN ADVANCE OF FUNDS OF USD 2,500, IF POSSIBLE.

2. INTERPRETERS: POST INTENDS TO USE THE BEST AVAILABLE INTERPRETERS FOR THE FLOTUS AND AMBASSADOR ALBRIGHT. THE INTERPRETER WE PLAN TO USE FOR SECURITY IS LESS EXPENSIVE, BUT FULLY COMPETENT. TWO INTERPRETERS (SECURITY, SCHEDULING) FOR THE PRE-ADVANCE AT ESTIMATED COST USD 350. ONE INTERPRETER THE ADVANCE TEAM AT USD 150.00 PER DAY, AND THREE INTERPRETERS FOR THE DAY OF THE VISIT (FLOTUS, AMB ALBRIGHT, SECURITY), USD \$750.

3. VEHICLES: MOST VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PRE-ADVANCE WILL BE MET WITH VEHICLES BORROWED FROM ALL AGENCIES. HOWEVER, WE WILL STILL NEED TO USE SOME POVS AND TAXIS, AT AN ESTIMATED COST OF USD 100.00. A VEHICLE WITH DRIVER CAN BE RENTED FOR THE ADVANCE TEAM, AT A COST OF USD 200 PER DAY. THE SLOVAK GOVERNMENT HAS STATED THEY WILL PROVIDE VEHICLES FOR THE FLOTUS PARTY. HOWEVER, WE MAY NEED ADDITIONAL VEHICLES FOR AMBASSADOR ALBRIGHT'S PARTY.

4. TELEPHONES: POST ESTIMATES TELEPHONE RENTALS AND CALLS RELATED TO THE VISIT TO COME TO USD 1,000. JOHNSON

1. BASED ON A REUTER'S REPORT, SEVERAL MAJOR HUNGARIAN
DAILIES ANNOUNCED ON MAY 29 THAT HILLARY CLINTON PLANS
A VISIT TO EAST EUROPE INCLUDING STOPS IN POLAND, THE
CZECH REPUBLIC, SLOVAKIA, HUNGARY, ROMANIA, ESTONIA,
LATVIA, AND LITHUANIA. NO EXACT DATE FOR THE BUDAPEST
SEGMENT IS DISCLOSED BUT PAPERS EXPECT EARLY JULY AS
THE TARGET DATE FOR THE FIRST LADY'S VISIT.

2. TWO DAILIES, MAGYAR HIRLAP AND MAGYAR NEMZET, CARRY
A STORY THAT MRS. CLINTON MAY ADOPT A CHILD IN ROMANIA.
AS REPORTED BY THE PRESS AGENCY REUTER, THE ROMANIAN
PRESS GAVE WIDE COVERAGE TO A RECENT INTERVIEW IN TIME
MAGAZINE IN WHICH THE FIRST LADY REVEALED "THEY ARE
CONSIDERING TO ADOPT A CHILD." A ROMANIAN PAPER,
"LIBERTATEA," PROPOSED THAT THE CLINTONS ADOPT A CHILD
IN ROMANIA AND IMMEDIATELY OFFERED ITS ASSISTANCE IN
THE PROCEDURE. REUTER'S REMARKS THAT AMERICAN COUPLES
HAVE ADOPTED MORE THAN 1200 ORPHANS IN ROMANIA THIS
YEAR.

Hillary Clinton to visit Romania in July

BUCHAREST, Romania (Reuter) - U.S. First Lady Hillary Clinton is to visit Romania in July as part of a central and eastern European tour, diplomatic sources said Tuesday.

Mrs. Clinton, accompanied by U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations Madeline Albright, is due in Bucharest July 5.

The sources said Mrs. Clinton would spend at least 24 hours in Romania and visit humanitarian projects, see the problems of Bucharest street children and meet President Ion Iliescu and other officials.

Mrs. Clinton's tour is also expected to take in the Baltic republics, Poland, the Czech Republic, Hungary and Slovakia.

Iliescu has worked to improve relations with the United States and to overcome scepticism in Washington about the 1989 revolution and the fairness of subsequent elections. He had his first White House meeting with President Clinton last year.

Dear Mrs. Clinton,
My dear Hillary,

I am delighted to hear that you have accepted my invitation to Prague and that you and Madeleine Albright plan to come here on Wednesday, July 3. I will see to it that the program of your visit and all the related modalities meet your wishes in every way. Let me suggest that we arrange your accommodation at the Prague Hilton Hotel. Following your arrival, when you have rested after the journey, I would like to invite you to a special private tour of Prague Castle - a unique site of European history and the traditional seat of this country's Heads of State. In the early evening of the same day, we could - if you agreed - sit down together for a talk in the garden of my home, followed by a dinner in my house in a small private circle. On the following day, I would gladly accompany you for a tour of Charles Bridge, the Jewish cemetery or other historical monuments of Prague. It would be great if you visited also the Goodwill Committee Olga Havel Foundation and let its representatives show you some of our health or social welfare establishments. If you are interested, we will arrange also a visit to the Prague office of Radio Free Europe.

My associates are prepared to discuss with your team all the particulars.

I am truly looking forward to seeing you in Prague next July. Extending my warmest regards and best wishes also to your husband, I am,
