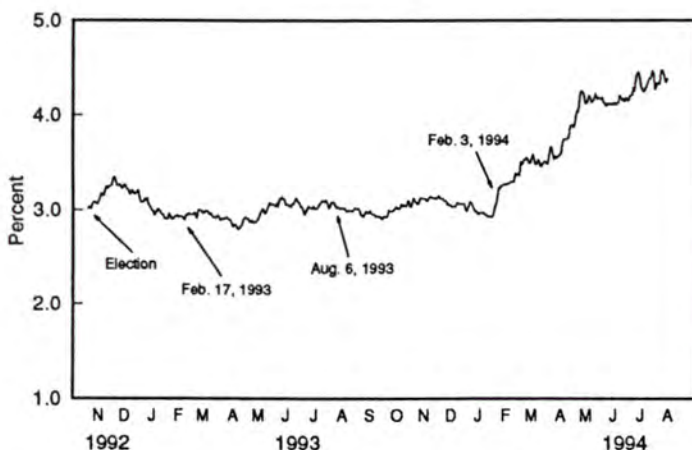
SUBJECT: Interest Rates and the Stock Market, Week Ending Friday, August 12, 1994

Interest rates changed little this week. Increases in long-term interest rates earlier in the week were offset by decreases on Friday following the release of CPI data showing that core inflation remained subdued. Changes in Treasury borrowing rates were as follows:

The stock market closed higher for the week. The broad-based S&P index closed Friday at 461.94, up 1.1 percent from the preceding Friday's close. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed Friday at 3768.71, up 0.6 percent for the week.
