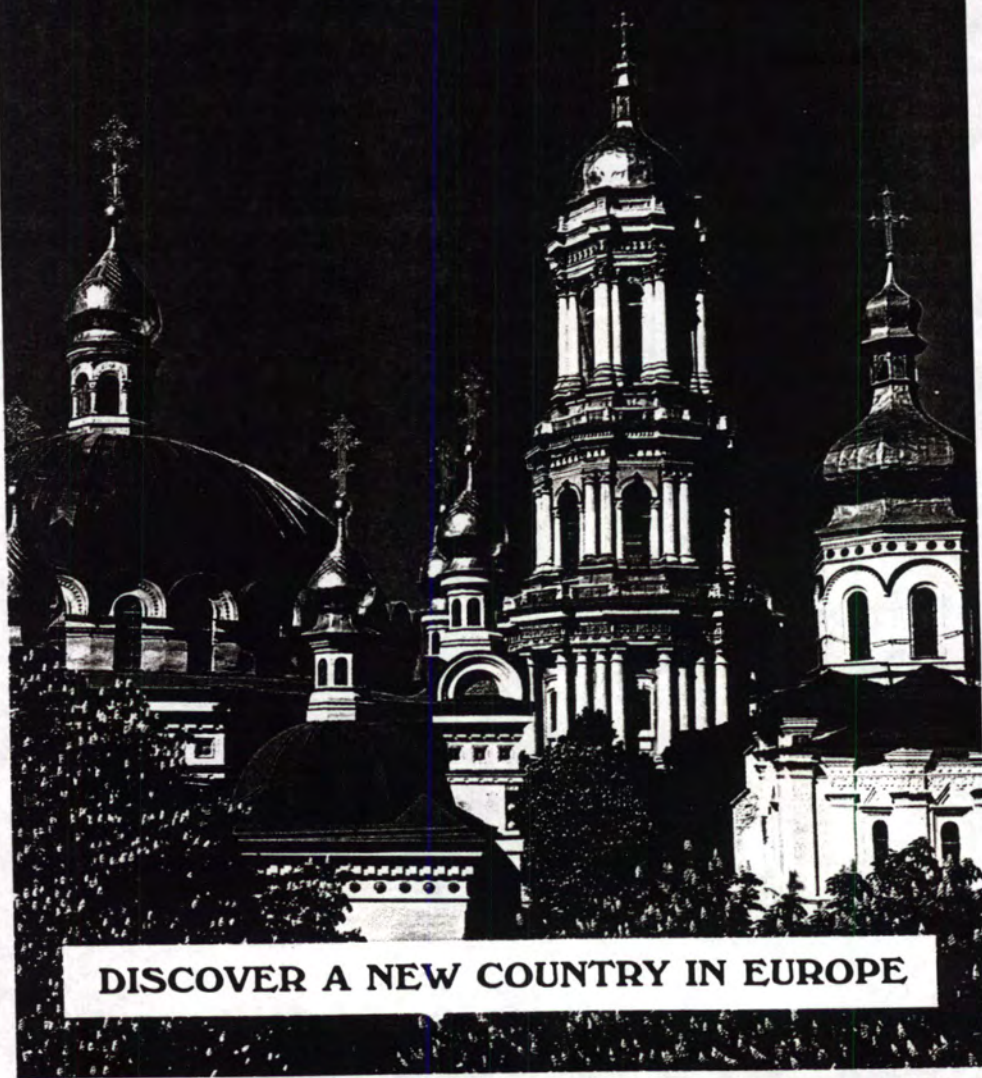

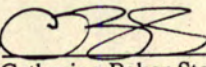

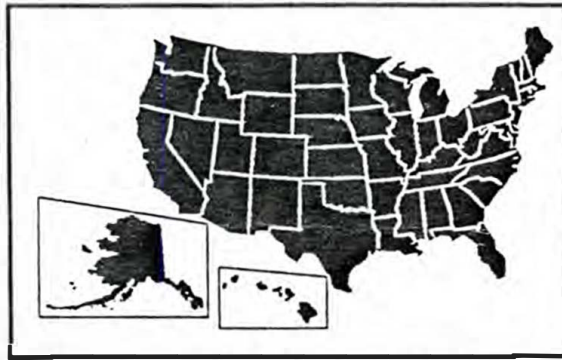

Gift: Lacrosse stick

Lacrosse stick makers Frank Benedict and his son Owen carve rugged lacrosse sticks out of hickory, the material traditionally used for the racquets in this game of Native American origin. Once carved the sticks are strung with leather and rawhide. American Indians played various forms of lacrosse long before the Europeans set foot on the continent. Today, thousands of both Native and non-Native athletes in colleges and professional leagues play both "box" and "field" versions of the game that was adapted by Canadians from the Iroquois in the mid-19th century. Ironically, non-Natives excluded Indians from professional competition for more than a century, and have developed plastic sticks, effectively supplanting the traditional wooden stick in official field lacrosse. The Benedicts are Mohawks living in St. Regis Mohawk Reservation, New York.



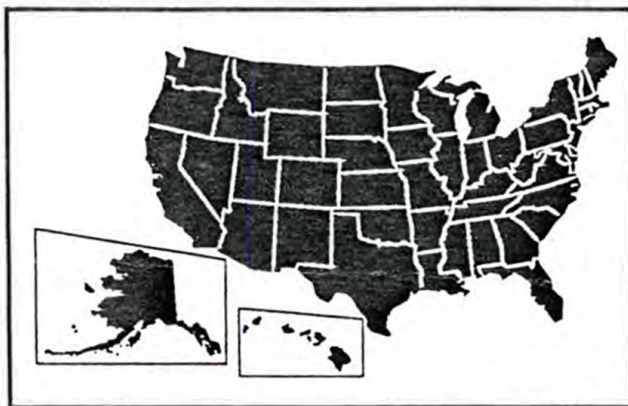
# LOUISE GOINGS

## *Basket Maker*

### Cherokee, North Carolina

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Louise Goings is a basketmaker from the Birdtown community on the Cherokee Reservation in North Carolina. Ms. Goings learned the craft from her mother. To make her baskets, she gathers white oak in the woods of the Great Smoky Mountains. Baskets are woven to be used either as decorative items for display or as containers — fruit baskets, picnic baskets, waste baskets, and even magazine holders. In addition to the natural color of white oak, many of Ms. Goings products are decorated with maple curls in a variety of colors obtained from natural substances also found locally, for example, brown from walnut leaves or bark and orange from bloodroot. Ms. Goings has several baskets on display in the Cherokee museum, but markets most of her items through the Qualla Co-op, a consortium of Cherokee basket makers, stone-carvers, and bead-workers.

# MARY JACKSON

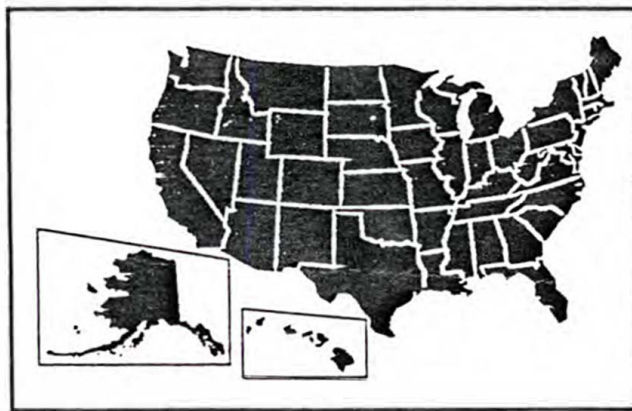

South Carolina Sea Island basketmaker Mary Jackson creates beautiful and useful baskets with an African coiling technique that came to the U.S. with enslaved people from Africa. Historically, African-Americans contributed to the establishment of European agriculture in the coastal wetlands of the Carolinas through their knowledge of the special tools and techniques needed in growing rice. Among these were winnowing and work baskets made of coiled grass. Today, their descendants perpetuate the tradition, using sweet grass and pine needles, twined with narrow strips of palmetto. Fashioning shapes that range from market baskets to serving trays to large storage containers, members of this tradition contribute artistic forms to American homes as a means of support for their own families.

In recent years, however, access to raw materials used in this basketmaking has been threatened by real estate development.

*Lei* maker Marie McDonald both practices and writes about her art. A public school teacher, she is also the owner and operator of a flower company and author of the definitive book on *lei* making. Hawaiian flower *leis* are made of indigenous plants as well as those transplanted to the Islands. *Leis* are presented to mark important occasions among family members and friends. As Ms. McDonald observes, flower *leis* have a precious, short-lived beauty. The moment when they are given is a moment of love. Thus, *leis* become like arms that entwine mother and child, lover and beloved, and friend to friend.

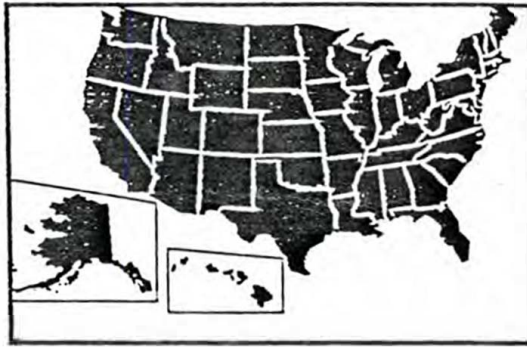

*Santos* carvers Sabinita Lopez Ortiz and her daughter, Amy Turk, create religious figures from wood in an Hispanic artistic tradition that has been practiced for centuries. It is particularly strong in their small community of Córdoba in the Sangre de Cristo mountains of northern New Mexico. *Santos* carving in northern New Mexico dates back more than 200 years to the early days of Spanish settlement, when local artisans began crafting brightly painted devotional images for use in Hispanic homes and Roman Catholic churches. Sabinita's grandfather, Jose Dolores Lopez, helped revive this art in the 1920s, shaping a new style out of his ancestor's tradition by making saints of unpainted cottonwood and cedar. Sabinita Ortiz carries on the tradition of her grandfather and her uncle, the renowned George Lopez. "They left a beautiful gift for all the family," she says. "We want to keep it going."



# TANYA OSADCA

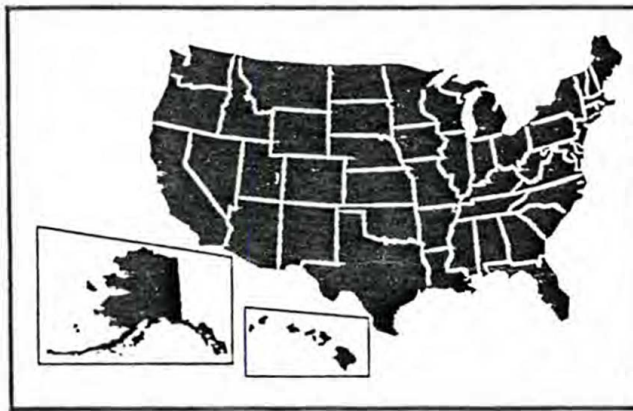

*Pysanky* egg dyer Tanya Osadca and her sister, Aka Pereyma, from Troy, Ohio, practice an ancient art brought to the United States from the Ukraine. In customary fashion, the sisters first learned egg dyeing from their mother. They use a wax resist process, drawing patterns in beeswax with a wooden stylus, building designs with colored dyes, and finally removing the wax. Women create *pysanky* for Easter, bring them to church for blessing, exchange them with friends and relatives, and display them in their homes year round. The *pysanky* tradition weakened due to the former Soviet Union's anti-religious policies. But with political change, this and other forms of traditional Ukraininan expression have been revived, and Ms.

Osadca has become a cultural resource for this tradition. An exhibition of her eggs is now touring the Ukraine, and she is preparing a book on the subject.

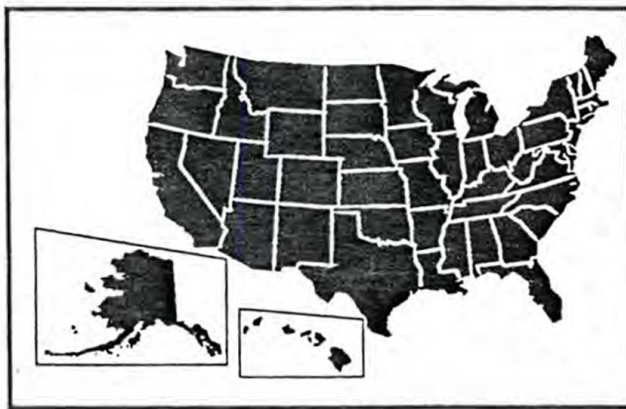

Using a knife he can fashion a set of lumberjacks from a bygone era, while with a chain saw, Mr. Richard creates large woodsmen and exuberant, whimsical bears of all sizes. 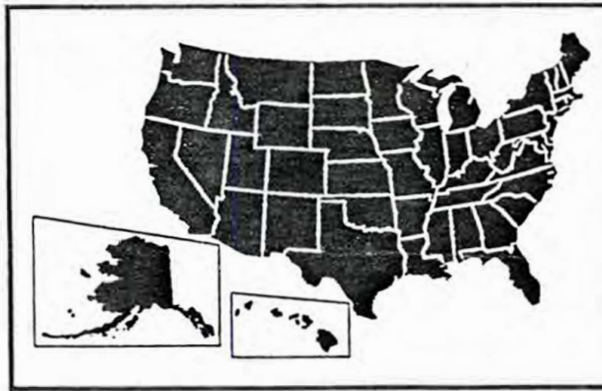
# TONI ROLLER & CLIFF ROLLER

Santa Clara Pueblo potter Toni Roller comes from a distinguished family of Native American artisans. She creates pots with pleasing form, graceful decorative lines, and the distinctive, luminous black finish that typifies much of the Santa Clara pottery. For centuries, Santa Clara potters have dug their own clay from the hills near their pueblo, while offering prayers to Mother Earth. The pots are shaped using coiling techniques, then fired in the open using cedar wood. The brilliant black shine is created by polishing the pottery with smooth stones — family heirlooms — before it is fired. The decorations represent water serpents, rain-clouds, buffalo horns and bear paws — all symbols of survival for her people. The deep carving and contrasting shiny and flat finishes distinctly mark Ms. Roller's ware as Santa Claran.

Paper cutter Tsirl Waletzky lives in the Bronx, New York, and practices an art that developed in Jewish communities in Europe and North Africa. Paper cuts — shaped from white paper or parchment and painted with watercolors — were used to decorate the eastern walls of homes and synagogues and indicate the direction of Jerusalem. Paper cuts were also made as part of the celebration of particular holidays, while other types had ritual uses or served as amulets. Designs incorporated images of the seven-branched *menorah* (candelabra), birds, plants, animals and motifs associated with the Bible and Jewish folklore. Ms. Waletzky is an university-trained artist who also works in stained glass.

In conjunction with a calligrapher, Jay Greenspan, she creates *Ketubot* (Jewish marriage contracts or certificates) with paper cut borders.

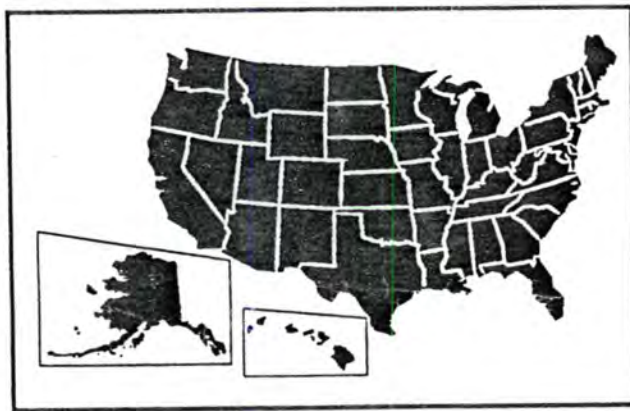

Patchwork quilter Arbie Williams lives in Oakland, California, but Ms. Williams first learned her art in eastern Texas, where she was raised. Like other African-American quilters in that area, including those from western Louisiana and southern Arkansas, she emphasizes strong design and brightly contrasting colors. She creates vibrant patterns by elaborating basic shapes into a variety of sizes and angular compositions. Some see in her work the same creative improvisation that musicians use in blues, jazz, and gospel music. For Ms. Williams, as with many women who sew quilts, the activity also helps to build a sense of community through socializing and working to meet shared goals.

- Markings: Flagship of 31st Fighter Wing, Aviano AB, Italy
- Unit Significance: 31 FW established at Aviano in April 1994 with two F-16 Block 40 squadrons to reestablish permanent U.S. airpower presence in NATO Southern Region following loss of Torrijon AB, Spain where an F-16 Wing was based. Since at Aviano, unit has distinguished itself frequently:
