SUBJECT: The dollar

Q: Mr. President is your Administration not going to take any action on the dollar and pursue a policy of benign neglect?

A: I am not going to comment on the specifics of what we are going to do. As we have said consistently we are serious, concerned and focused on the dollar and we will not use the dollar as an instrument of trade. I believe that the fundamentals of the U.S. economy are sound.

Just a note, the more we say the more we get interpreted as a policy of benign neglect.

And we are all seeing how we can improve our national productivity when all of us working together put our minds to that goal. And I applaud you for your role in that accomplishment.
