Items for President Clinton

International Criminal Court

- The deadline for the signing of the Statute is December 31, 2000.
- Canada is chair of the negotiating process.
- Provided the integrity of the Statute is maintained, Canada will work with the USA to accommodate USA concerns.
- It is hoped that the USA can demonstrate its continued global leadership on the issue of eliminating impunity for war crimes by signing the Statute by December 31, 2000.

Arctic Natural Wildlife Reserve (ANWAR)

- Canada has long opposed opening ANWAR to economic development, specifically oil and gas exploitation.
- We will continue to protect our areas adjacent to this area.
- Recent USA campaign declarations, suggest that ANWAR may be vulnerable to future development.
- Canada would be pleased if the President were to declare ANWAR a national monument.

Softwood Lumber

- Canada has proposed to USTR the appointment of an eminent persons group (as was the case for the Pacific Salmon issue) to report to both governments.
- The eminent persons group would examine the basic aspects of this issue and propose a process on the expiry of the Softwood Lumber Agreement on March 31, 2001.
- Acceptance of this approach could facilitate the finding of common ground so as to avoid a costly and complex trade dispute.

Potatoes from Prince Edward Island:

- Discussions are ongoing between the US Department of Agriculture and the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) regarding the discovery of potato wart on one field in P.E.I.
- During this examination process, all P.E.I.'s potato exports have been banned to the USA.
- The CFIA has responded to USDA's requests for scientific evidence that the problem has been isolated and contained.
- It is hoped that USDA will quickly lift the ban on the export of P.E.I. potatoes now that the science has cleared any doubts concerning the status of the potatoes.

Dear Mr. President,

I would like to testify in Congress for two reasons:

1. To raise the consciousness of Congress about the need to provide a free "Vial of Life" to all senior citizens. And to seek the release of funds by any government programs that might help this effort.

Currently, American Senior Safety Agency distributes a "Vial of Life" for free to all senior citizens who want one

The Vial is a simple passive lifesaving system.

Thousands of lives around the world have been saved or assisted during emergencies by the Vial. It speaks for an injured or distressed person when they can't. Basically, the "Vial of Life" gives any emergency personnel that arrive at a scene, complete medical information about the patient by grabbing the information from the refrigerator door, glove compartment, or in their wallet. It lists all of a persons medications, dosages, and frequency. The Vial contains complete medical history, as well as...insurance, doctor, hospital, and family information. It can contain, recent cardiograms, "Do Not Resuscitate Notification", hospice directions etc.

In 1981, the American Red Cross in Sacramento, California helped my medical alarm company begin dispensing this incredible program by supplying us with our first decals. My companies have since continued distributing the "Vial of Life" throughout the United States at no charge to seniors. We have distributed more than 100,000 Vials to the senior community for free.

Our organization continuously receives requests from municipalities, police departments, the Boy Scouts and other organizations to help them setup similar programs. We always assist in every way possible.

Interestingly, this program is not owned by any specific organization.

We are a small company attempting to do an enormous task. I think government could assist seniors in a huge way for a tiny cost. The complete package costs less than a dollar to deliver. Imagine, saving life for less than a dollar per person.

Our company also benefits from distributing the "Vial of Life". It is a good deed that introduces seniors to our medical alarm system.

Medical alarms save lives on an active basis.

This brings me to my second reason to testify before congress.

2. I would also like to testify to raise the consciousness of Congress about the need seniors have for a medical alarm, and to ask them to provide funding for medical alarms under Medicare so that seniors can stay in their own homes for a longer period of time. This improves a senior's quality of life while reducing government's cost of medical care. It also keeps the children of seniors on the job knowing that their parents can get help if needed.

A medical alarm, which once cost \$1800 plus \$30 per month to monitor, now costs only \$29.95 per month, complete.

It is a pendant transmitter that is worn, even in the shower and tub, that allows a senior to get help when they need it most, when they are alone and in trouble...and unable to reach the phone for help.

People wind up in nursing homes, everyday, because they had an emergency, they needed help...and nobody knew about it. That's just not right.

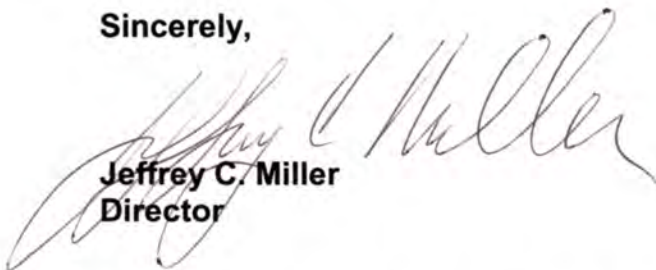
To conclude:

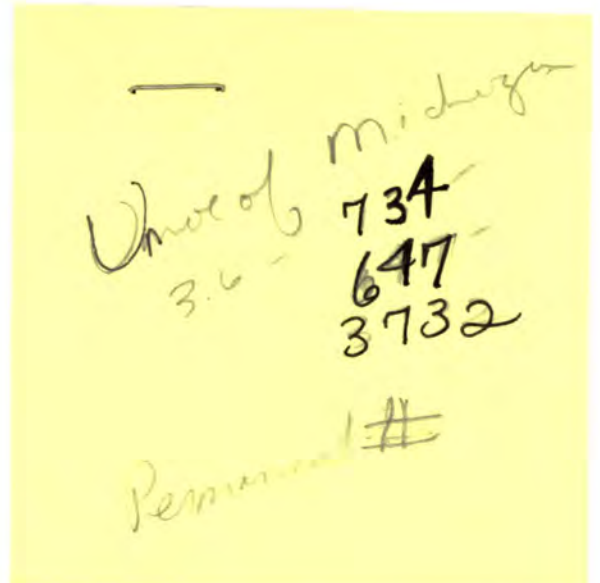

An Open Letter to President William Jefferson Clinton
From: Rabbi Gene Levy and Imam Johnny Hasan
Reference: PEACE MAKERS & PEACE-INITIATORS

As terrorism and violent clashes continue to claim victims in the struggles in and around Jerusalem and The West Bank, we call upon you to renew your efforts to mediate an end to the conflict. As Rabbi and Imam, the two of us have spoken between ourselves and among our congregants and associates, and we recognize that there is definitely a religious, as well as political component involved, and we would thereby suggest that the Jewish, Christian, and Muslim religious leaders be brought to the table, as well. We know that rabbis, priests, and imams could offer not only prayer, but practical spiritual insights to end the violence. We also know that attitudes and behavior are often shaped by the Middle East's religious leadership. If peace is to be established in Jerusalem, in Palestine, and in the land of Judaism, Christianity, and Al-Islam, it should be established by the peace-makers and peace-initiators, namely the rabbis, priests, and imams of the faithful.

We know that, as the most respected leader of the free world, who also has the power to bring together all sides in this volatile conflict, you, Mr. President are really the only person who can inspire the trust to do so. We pray that, before you leave your position as President, you can find the time and the resources to invite rabbis, priests, and imams from the Middle Eastern areas, and from other affected areas like East Jerusalem, to consult with each other for the sake of PEACE!

Together, we are writing to offer to help you, when and where we can, and together we pray for your success in the challenge. With grateful thanks for all you have done to try to achieve a just and lasting peace, we ask you now to consider this bold new step with religious leaders.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: Tunisia and Europe Trip (6-11 October)

I recently returned from a successful trip with stops in Tunis for bilateral meetings; in Thessaloniki, Greece, where I attended the meeting of Southeastern European Defense Ministers; and Birmingham, England, where I participated in the NATO Informal Defense Ministerial Meeting.

Tunisia

My first stop was in Tunisia. I had very frank and positive discussions with President Ben Ali and the Minister of Defense Mohamed Jegham. Ben Ali immediately spoke of our excellent and strategic bilateral relationship. He also expressed his desire to see the relationship further strengthened, including in the military realm, though, as you know, he is wisely giving by far the greatest priority to economic development. On the Iraq issue, he believed the sanctions against Iraq were not working but I emphasized to him that they were preventing Saddam from reconstituting his WMD arsenal and threatening his neighbors as well as his own people. With regard to the MEPP, Ben Ali wants to be constructive but has limits, as more recent events have shown. During the meeting, he said the Israeli/Palestinian clashes were predictable, given the sensitivity of the Jerusalem issue. Consistent with his general approach, his comments refrained from anti-Israeli diatribes and focused on getting the Israelis and Palestinians back to the negotiating table.

On Maghreb issues, Ben Ali gave a downbeat assessment of Algerian President Bouteflika, though he stressed that the bilateral relationship with Algeria was actually very good. He believes that Bouteflika is out of touch with his country's realities because of his lengthy absence from Algeria. He also said that Bouteflika's government lacks clear ideas on how to solve the country's problems. On Morocco, Ben Ali was worried that King Mohamed had made too many promises to his people and expressed concern over perceived growing influence of Islamic extremists in Morocco. He also indicated that the UN Referendum Plan for Western Sahara is not working. He believes a negotiated settlement is the only way to resolve this conflict. Ben Ali expressed hope that the US will expand its presence in the Maghreb region, asserting that it was not the private preserve of anyone (read France). He also registered concern over what he saw as the lack of progress on the Eizenstat Initiative (US-North African Economic Partnership).

During my separate discussions with Minister of Defense Jegham, he reaffirmed the importance of our close defense cooperation and hoped it would be bolstered by expanding combined exercises and additional security assistance for the modernization and maintenance of the Tunisian Armed Forces.



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Southeast European Defense Ministerials

As events in Belgrade unfolded in early October, I met with nine Southeast European Ministers of Defense in Thessaloniki, Greece. This was the fourth time I had attended the Southeast European Defense Ministerials (SEDM), a very successful initiative we started several years ago, with five regional (Albania, Macedonia, Bulgaria, Romania, Slovenia) and four NATO (US, Italy, Greece, Turkey) members. SEDM has spawned a number of practical cooperative efforts in the region, including a peacekeeping brigade (which will probably be used in Bosnia) and an engineer task force (which will begin with road building in Albania). SEDM has been a modest success story in building regional stability, cooperation and good neighborly relations in this difficult area, mostly getting Greece and Turkey to work together successfully on the development of the peacekeeping brigade. In this light, it was noteworthy that we welcomed Croatia's presence at the meeting for the first time. The fact that Croatia is now a member of SEDM says important things about the rapid, positive changes in the region—a fact underscored by the developments in Belgrade even as we met. Bringing Serbia into the SEDM in the not too distant future will be a useful step, though all the countries wanted to ensure that there was actual progress in taking that step. I also spent time with Greek MoD Akis Tsohatzopoulos, with a follow on meeting to develop US-Greek cooperation, mostly in the Balkans and the Mediterranean.

NATO Informal Defense Ministerial Meeting 10 October

The Birmingham Ministerial meeting occurred during a period of historic change in European security. Both NATO Allies and European Union (EU) members are in the process of determining capabilities needed to perform their organizations' respective security and defense missions. This endeavor requires an objective assessment of the current and projected threat environment, honest identification of capabilities shortfalls, and perhaps most importantly, NATO-EU cooperation to rectify those shortfalls without unnecessary and costly duplication. NATO and EU capabilities are inextricably interrelated, as the only common pool of European forces. Therefore, this NATO-EU relationship demands close, transparent cooperation to establish a unified, collaborative defense planning review process, and provide for assured EU access to NATO operational and force planning.

Four EU-NATO working groups have been formed and meet regularly to discuss the mechanics of defense cooperation. In September, NATO ambassadors met with their EU counterparts for the first time in an historic meeting. There is a great deal of work that remains to be done in establishing NATO-EU security and defense links. The Ministerial meeting provided me with an opportunity to reiterate our commitment to NATO and European security while also demonstrating our leadership in establishing closer ties between NATO and the EU. I emphasized our strong support for the EU goal of developing its own security and defense policy with a credible military capability to back it up, and offered a vision of NATO-EU relations that includes a unitary planning review process. It is my strong belief that it would be inadvisable to create separate parallel

NATO and EU defense planning processes as that would contradict the reality that NATO and the EU will draw from the same pool of forces. Separate, duplicative staffs would also waste already precious resources. To demonstrate our seriousness, I invited the four non-NATO EU members (Austria, Finland, Ireland, and Sweden) and France to observe NATO's examination of our forces committed to the Alliance (which is a key element of NATO's defense planning process) on 2 November.

The reaction to my intervention was overwhelmingly positive. Both Defense Ministers and media commented on the strong statement of our support for the EU's Security and Defense Policy and our willingness to lead the development of NATO-EU links in these areas. With the next Defense Ministerial Meeting scheduled for early December, we are working closely with our Mission at NATO and our Country Teams in EU member states to finalize as many of these NATO-EU security and defense links as possible before the end of the year.

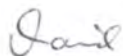
It has been my privilege to work rather closely with President Carter and with President Gorbachev in their post presidency years. These experiences have been stimulating and encouraging.

RE: HOMESTEAD AIRBASE TRANSFER

* | This is a quick update on the Homestead Airbase Transfer since the meeting on December 12. As you know, the Record of Decision will be ripe for release beginning January 15, 2001 and there is work to be done in drafting the document in the intervening weeks. While we reached a tentative agreement on a course of action whereby the Air Force would transfer the property to the Department of the Interior to offer first to Dade County for mixed use development and, if rejected by the county, to other developers as an exchange of property, no final decision was made. It appeared from the discussion that mixed-use development was preferable to a commercial airport.

Nonetheless, we are aware that several advocates of transfer of the base property to Dade County for a commercial airport have been reaching or attempting to reach the President, including Secretary Slater on behalf of FAA, as well as John Merrigan and George Mitchell, who represent the HABDI interests.

* | Despite the fact that there is no authority for Interior to transfer the property to Dade County directly (absent compensation), consistent with the alternative we discussed, it poses no impediment to otherwise proceeding as we had discussed. There is ample legal authority by which the Air Force could itself offer the property to Dade County for a non-airport mixed-use development. If the county expressed no desire to receive the property under those conditions, the Record of Decision could then provide that the Air Force would offer it to Interior, again consistent with the alternative we discussed.

The important matter is that we make the disposal decision soon so that the Record of Decision can be written within the time remaining. Please call me with any questions.

Dear Mr. President:

I am writing on behalf of my client, Robert J. Guidry, whose case is pending before the United States District Court for the Middle District of Louisiana. Mr. Guidry, an extremely important government witness, was charged with and pleaded guilty to a single count of conspiracy to commit extortion. Mr. Guidry is expected to be sentenced in the early part of January, 2001.

Mr. Guidry was the government's principal witness in the case against former Governor Edwin Edwards. Mr. Guidry testified that after having some fifteen million dollars invested in the construction of a riverboat casino, he was extorted by Edwards under the threat that the state police would withhold the suitability hearing which was the final step in the licensing process.

The government lawyers, who were very much pleased with the level of my client's cooperation, are in the process of preparing a 5K motion for submission to the judge. We believe the chances are very favorable for a suspended sentence. Even should that happen, however, Mr. Guidry will continue to suffer the civil disadvantages of a felony conviction.

Robert Guidry, a life-long resident of Louisiana, has never before been convicted of a criminal offense. He is a self-made businessman who has made

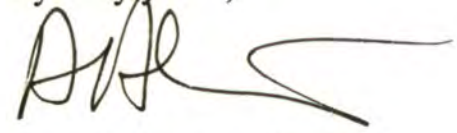

I have been in constant contact with the governments that have participated in the Third Way. They remain enthusiastic about your future role in the Progressive Governance network. There is widespread feeling that your skills are needed. This is true for Europe and elsewhere.

At the September meeting in New York, you spoke about the need for (a) political support; (b) dissemination of ideas; (c) continuing renewal of ideas; and (d) deepening of bonds.

After the presidency, you can work in these areas in the following ways: You can travel to various countries, where you can meet with leaders and elements within their parties, as well as those in think tanks and universities. You can make media appearances, through television interviews, speeches, articles, and Internet linkups. And you can play a role in the meetings and networks as moderator and participant. Wherever you go, you can draw together the political figures, thinkers, activists, etc.

In the short-run, it would be useful to address the ideas and issues of the Third Way, providing a kind of political roadmap, or testament, building on your previous statements, including the Berlin Communiqué. This can take the form of a speech before leaving the presidency, or a longer article to be published after January 20th.

The most immediate political event internationally will be the British election, probably to take place in May 2001. Your appearance in Britain should be used to underscore Third Way ideas and values about the emerging global social compact.

You should also consider another trip to London, perhaps in March, before the campaign there begins in earnest. This should be a topic of discussion with Tony Blair on the visit.

The next international Third Way leaders' meeting, to follow on New York, Berlin and Florence, will take place in Stockholm in September. A work program is being developed. There has already been a sherpas' meeting this month about which I am fully informed. The Swedes are moving ahead with great seriousness and without complication. The network is taking a practical, political direction, following your remarks in the Berlin meeting. The Berlin Communique remains a base point, but the theme for next year will be "Best Practice in Progressive Governance." The Swedes have agreed to serve as a clearinghouse to collect policy practice from all countries under seven areas: health care, welfare reform, crime/drugs, environment, digital divide, immigration/asylum, and global development. In June or July, an experts' conference will convene in Stockholm, an occasion for the presentation of papers in each area. The leaders' meeting will focus on only three areas, yet to be decided. Throughout the year, the network should build toward the meeting, internally and also in terms of media publicity.

There is no friction about your role. On the contrary, your presence is urgently wanted. Your exact role at the Stockholm leaders' meeting must be carefully and precisely worked out. Once you leave office, we must decide how to use our networks and foundations (the Clinton Center, the DLC's Third Way Foundation, etc.) in relation to the meeting. I believe you should serve as the moderator at the meeting and play a rightful role as participant because of your historic role as the originator of the movement. We should discuss that as well with Blair. I have already begun discussions with his staff. The first step now should be to solidify all these matters with him.

SUBJ: North Korea Trip

Dear Mr. President:

As you know, for some years I have had a keen interest in North Korea and have traveled there more than virtually any U.S. civilian. After my most recent trips, which occurred shortly before I joined the White House staff, I provided my observations to Sandy.

I know you are contemplating making a Presidential visit to North Korea prior to leaving office. Mr. President, I would consider it an extraordinarily high honor to be able to accompany you on your visit to Pyongyang.

As a senior officer of a major corporation, as the former vice chairman of AmeriCares, and as a current board member of The Center for Democracy, it seems that I would make a logical member of the delegation accompanying you.

Also, I recommend that your visit include a small number of U.S. business and humanitarian representatives. To the extent that I can be of service in organizing the involvement of U.S. business interests or specific humanitarian activity coincident with your visit to Pyongyang, just let me know.

You may recall that on one of my visits to Pyongyang you asked me to pass along a message to North Korean leader Kim Jong Il indicating your continued willingness to work toward common ground. As I reported, on that trip I met with the head of the Americas Branch of the DPRK's Foreign Ministry in Pyongyang and I passed along your message.

North Korea is one of the few remaining truly dark spots on the globe. It is certainly appropriate that opening sincere dialogue with Pyongyang would be a major foreign policy accomplishment. As a former member of your White House staff, I would consider it a special honor to be able to return once again to North Korea with you.

If you focus on world hunger and poverty after you leave the White House you could lead a process that would cut world hunger in half by 2015 – and end widespread hunger in the United States much sooner.

At the Cabinet Room meeting on poor-country debt, you sketched an exciting vision. You suggested that the diverse coalition for debt relief could grow into a big sustained coalition to reduce poverty and hunger worldwide. I was thrilled when you told me that you yourself intend to work on this.

It is now feasible to cut world hunger in half by 2015. The financial cost would be only \$4 billion a year from all the industrialized countries. 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Bread for the World has already started to approach various institutions about forging an Alliance to End Hunger. Leon Panetta (a Bread for the World board member), Susan Berresford (president of the Ford Foundation), and George Rupp (president of Columbia University) are helping me. We could shape this work to support what you may have in mind.

In our view, the Alliance should aim to end widespread hunger in our own country as well as worldwide. Americans are concerned about hunger in their own communities, and we could achieve dramatic progress against hunger in America within a few years. In today's economy, a \$5 billion annual increase in the national nutrition programs would cut U.S. hunger and food insecurity in half. Food banks would soon be reporting reduced hunger in communities across the country. That would help convince people that hunger is one problem we can actually solve, and that the key is to get our government to do its part. Clear progress against domestic hunger would help us push for progress against world hunger and for a broader anti-poverty agenda in the United States.

We are planning an April meeting to organize the Alliance to End Hunger. We will invite institutions that are prepared to commit additional resources to changing the politics of hunger.
