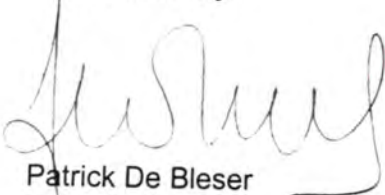
Millennium Bomb

Millennium Bomb

We learned from the European Commission yesterday that the British Government, currently president of the G8, is putting the Millennium Bomb issue high on the agenda at the next G8 summit meeting in Birmingham on 15th and 17th May. I am writing to offer our assistance in providing a presentation on this issue.

PA Consulting is one of the leading authorities on the Millennium Bomb, and have recently released our fifth survey report, an international analysis of the Year 2000 problem. This latest survey has generated high levels of media attention world-wide, and has played a significant role in highlighting the urgency of the Millennium Bomb with senior decision-makers in government, commerce, and industry. A management summary of the report is attached.

PA also has a long track record in designing and implementing a response to the Millennium Bomb. We have worked with some 50 major public- and private-sector organisations over the last two years to help them address the problem, which has given us invaluable insight into the special challenges it poses.

PA has been invited to give presentations to many European institutions, including the FEE, the Générale de Banque, the Belgian Employers Federation, the Belgian Government, the Dutch Employers Federation, the CNPF French employers Federation. We would welcome the opportunity to present to the G8 Group in Birmingham in May.

I will call you next week to see if this proposal is of interest to you. In the meantime, do not hesitate to contact me if you have any immediate questions.

Dear Mr. President:

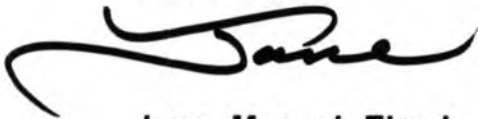
In lieu of the recent shooting in a Jonesboro, Arkansas, middle school, I was asked to comment on Tiger Vision, a Texas High television program, on how I felt about security at our school. I told my audience that I believed in our school's security but that our security should be visible all over our rather spread-out campus. (Often, our security personnel is divided and sent to different campuses, dissipating their effectiveness.) Then I started thinking about all of the schools in our country that have been built into beautiful, wooded landscapes; it would be safer to have security placed, at all times, in the back of schools, as well as in the front of the school and in the corridors. Obviously, violence in our schools is a growing problem which we need to address immediately. Why can't all schools have a security force? I wish that we did not need security, like when we were back in school; but wishing does not take care of the problem; America's schools need security!

More than that, however, is my strong belief that every school in America should not only have an active security force, but they should also have a very strong and active personal counselor team. I think that we have always needed personal counselors, but the need is growing: there are more abused children than ever, there are more absentee parents than ever, there are more deaths due to violence than ever, and there is more general meanness than ever. Our school of 1500 students had, in the past, four counselors: one for every grade level or one for every 500 students. They did, however, little personal counseling, concentrating on credits, scholarships, and graduation. This year, we have one personal counselor, who is supposed to deal with 1500 students, and three academic counselors, which causes several of the academic counselors to double their work load. Our one personal counselor

is swamped every day with very serious student problems: incest, anger, hurt, loss, ect. It is my belief that counselors should, if at all possible, reflect the cultural diversity of the school population. Why can't all schools have enough personal counselors to help our students? In my school, we need an academic counselor for every grade level and a personal counselor for every grade level, which would make a total of eight counselors. Unmistakably, having more personal counselors would enable us to develop pro-active activities and groups; having more personal counselors would allow us more contact with the general population, thus depleting the number of growing problems before they explode into irreversible damage.

Finally, I know that you are thought of as the President who cares about the welfare of our students and their education. I also know that this letter does not contain anything that you have not already considered; however, I feel so strongly about this that I had to write. I think that it is past time for changes in our educational system, and this letter conveys my thoughts on only a few pressing ones that I feel need to be addressed immediately.
