Dear President Clinton:

I am writing you concerning the flood of cheap foreign steel that is being dumped into this country.

We must limit the foreign imports of steel that have thrown the American steel industry into dire emergency. They are saturating the U.S. market with steel prices that are actually less than the cost of producing it. American companies are being driven into bankruptcy, which is threatening the jobs of American steelworkers.

The resolution, H. Con. Res. 328 states that other countries, including those in Europe, refuse to let Russia and Asian countries dump steel into their countries, United States must do the same.

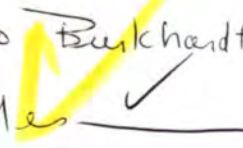

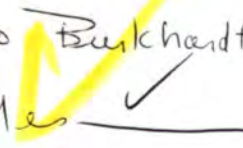

Dear President Clinton:

As you know, my son, and your friend, Rory Deutsch died from a brain stem tumor in July, 1998. As a living tribute to Rory, on July 24, 1998, The Rory David Deutsch Foundation (the "Foundation") was established.

The Foundation is a not-for-profit corporation which was formed to raise money and contribute resources toward brain tumor and pediatric research. The Foundation's primary activities will be fund raising, public education and the distribution of funds for medical research.

The founding members of the Foundation are currently working on obtaining 501(c)(3) status as a public charity for the Foundation and building the cornerstone for what is hoped to become a nationally prominent public charity committed to "Reaching Out, Researching, Yearning for a Brighter Tomorrow" through fund raising and the charitable activities described above.

As part of our mission, we are working on assembling a Board of Directors, which will be made up of people committed to working on a volunteer basis on behalf of the Foundation, a Scientific Advisory Board, which will be made up of medical professionals who will aid the Board of Directors in selecting appropriate organizations or projects to receive contributions and an honorary Board of Advisors, which will be made up of community leaders who desire to lend their names and support to the Foundation.

The purpose of this letter is to formally request your agreement to become a member of the Board of Advisors. You were a wonderful friend to Rory in his life. We will always treasure the picture we have of Rory with you. Moreover, I was greatly touched when you mentioned to me and Jim Levin at the event at the Chicago Historical Society this summer that you would be interested in lending your support to the Foundation.

Good morning. For 6 yrs ~~as President~~, I have worked hard to ~~strengthen~~ ^{purge} our nation for ~~the new challenges of the~~ 21st Century. ~~In that time, we have brought fiscal discipline back to our government. We have addressed longstanding social problems, from rising crime to welfare, that once seemed impervious to our efforts. We have worked to strengthen American leadership in the world. And we have labored to bring people together as one American community.~~

In all ~~this~~ the White House staff plays a critical role.

~~For~~ ^{the} for the past two years, I have been blessed to have as my Chief of Staff a gifted manager and an inspiring leader, ~~the~~ ^{the} ~~was~~ ^{was} ~~but~~ ^{but} ~~never~~ ^{never} ~~met~~ ^{met} ~~a~~ ^a ~~great~~ ^{great} ~~person~~ ^{person} ~~named~~ ^{named} Erskine Bowles. When Erskine took this position in 1996, I asked him to finish the job of balancing the budget, and more than any other single individual, he was responsible for the agreement last year that wiped the red ink from the books in Washington.

He cares passionately about education, and led the negotiating team to impressive victories last week on behalf of our schools. ~~As I said the other day, he certainly knows how to stage an exit. He cares deeply about uniting our people, and poured his heart into our race initiative. In all of this he has helped mold a streamlined White House that works as a team. Just as important to me, he is a true friend~~

Erskine has made it plain how ~~badly he misses his family and neighbors, and~~ ~~he stayed in Washington because he wanted to be around to~~ ~~returning to North Carolina. I am only pleased I was able to persuade him to stay this long. I know he has a lot to give this country and his community and I hope he has the opportunity to do so in the future.~~

~~My sadness over losing Erskine is tempered by my~~
~~enthusiasm for the man who will replace him.~~ To follow the ~~the~~
 strong leadership ~~of Erskine Bowles,~~ I ~~need~~ ^{have} someone who
 is a powerful manager and a skilled policymaker, with a
 sharp mind and a giving heart. John Podesta has all those
 qualities, and that is why today I am naming him my White
 House Chief of Staff.

I can think of no chief of staff in recent memory better
 prepared for the job. From his days as Chief Counsel of the
 Senate Agriculture Committee, to his time as a law
 professor, to his service as an advisor to a generation of
 lawmakers, John Podesta has been at the heart of public
 policy and public life.

He has helped guide our foreign, defense and economic policy, served as a key liaison to Congress, and most recently represented me as a leader of the budget negotiating team that delivered a balanced budget that invests in education. With the singular exception of the Vice President, John is the most technologically proficient of our administration, guiding our technology policy on many fronts.

He has given us with.

He knows how the White House works. [^] But even more importantly, he knows why the White House ought to work – and for whom we all work. He entered public service for the right reasons, and he has stayed there for the right reasons.

As many of you know, he and his family have a taste for riding roller coasters -- and I know that will serve him well here. John Podesta combines a brilliant mind, a tough hide, a dry wit, hard-won wisdom and a passionate concern for improving this nation. He will be a great Chief of Staff.

And he will lead a seasoned White House team, working with Deputy Chief of Staff Maria Echaveste and their colleagues, that works hard every day for the taxpayers. John and his team will have a lot of work to do. We have balanced the budget, and now we have set aside the record budget surplus. We know that Social Security is strong today, but that if we do not act, it will face a crisis in the future as the Baby Boomers retire.

And we have an opportunity to act, in a bipartisan way, to strengthen Social Security for the next generation. The next Congress will be the Congress that I will call upon to save Social Security.

There are other important challenges as well: strengthening our economy at a time of global economic turmoil ... strengthening families through a Patients Bill of Rights ... expanding opportunity through an increase in the minimum wage ... modernizing our schools ... and more.

With a strong team in place, I am looking forward to pressing forward toward these goals in the months and years ahead.
