Firstly, let me say that it has been a true honor and pleasure meeting you today and a day that I will cherish in my heart for many years to come.

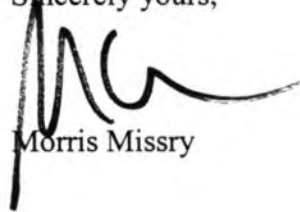
During the Jewish high holy days every year it is customary in the Sephardic Jewish community to say a prayer for the President of the United States. The prayer includes a blessing of the President to the United States and an implicit hope on all of our parts that the President carry out his duties in a respectful and dignified manner. During your campaign in 1992, you made a very serious and everlasting impression upon me with your sincerity and endless passion to remediate the problems that we as a country suffered from, including but not limited to, a fledgling economy. To all of our benefit the fruits of your labor have reared themselves and the economy is once again strong, America is at the forefront of human rights, and once again respected throughout the world as the most important and influential sovereign nation in the world.

But let me not forget to mention what, to me is one, if not the most important issues and examples of your tremendous ability to accomplish things that many have failed or even attempted to accomplish. I was very touched by your sensitivity to the Middle East peace process and specifically the right of the State of Israel to protect its borders and inhabitants. Your never-ending desire to facilitate an accord between the Israelis and the Palestinians and unwavering support of the peace process is unparalleled. During the press conference that took place after the Wye negotiations, the one theme that permeated the comments made by Prime Minister Netanyahu and Chairman Arafat was their sincere appreciation and recognition of your tireless efforts in prodding each of them to negotiate a fair and in some people's minds controversial peace plan. The only request I have is that you continue to insert yourself into the midst of the Wye Agreement and mandate that each of the sides adhere to their commitments.

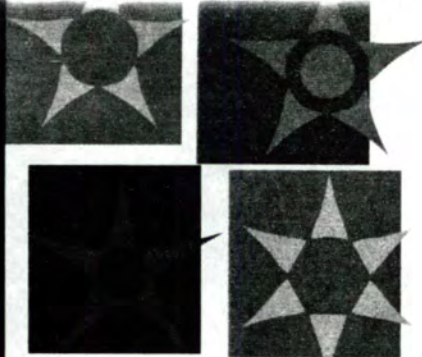

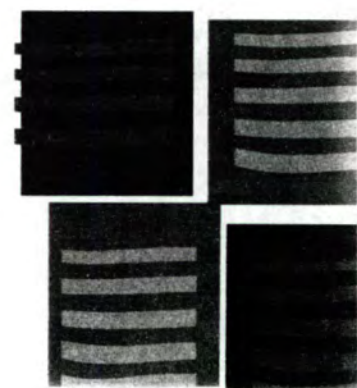
