Attached is a list of fifteen people who, barring any legal problems, will serve on the Advisory Committee on Human Radiation Experiments created by Executive Order (attached). Jack Gibbon's office chaired an Interagency Process that came up with the list.

According to Bill Kennedy's office, only Ruth Faden (the chairperson of the committee), has been name-checked by the FBI and vetted through the Counsel's office. She is ready to be appointed. Of the remaining fourteen, seven have been name-checked and seven are still at the FBI. Once we receive all of the name-checks from the FBI (and with the approval of the Counsel's office and all other appropriate White House sign-offs) we hope to release their names to the Hill and to the media. The release would be something like "The President, upon final ethical and legal background checks, intends to name the following people to the Advisory Committee on Human Radiation Experiments...." We hope to have the first meeting of the Committee in roughly three weeks; the President may attend.

HUMAN RADIATION EXPERIMENTS

FACT SHEET

SECRECY OF EXPERIMENTS

Although many of these experiments were secret at the time they were conducted, some information about most experiments has been public, but little known, for a number of years. Some results have been published in medical journals.

AVAILABILITY OF RECORDS

Because records have been kept individually at locations scattered across the nation, information about these experiments as a whole has not been accessible to the public. The Markey report was based on interpretive summaries of original research records, not on the records themselves.

THE INFORMED CONSENT ISSUE

There are serious questions about whether the subjects of these experiments were aware of what was being done to them or gave "informed consent" as it was defined at the time.

THE COMPENSATION ISSUE

If our review determines that American citizens were treated wrongfully by their government, we believe this Administration owes the American people a full accounting and where justified, an attempt to right any wrong done to individuals.

However, it is far too early to tell if this review will determine that compensation is warranted.

THE PRIVACY ISSUE

Patient records are protected by privacy considerations and traditionally not made public without consent of the subjects or their survivors. When records are received, names and identifiers will be kept in confidence until consent can be obtained.

CURRENT RESEARCH

Although the government still sponsors research on human subjects, it has adopted strict regulations requiring informed consent and high ethical conduct. All such research is reviewed regularly by oversight panels. Further review of existing federal guidelines on human experimentation may be appropriate.

HUMAN RADIATION EXPERIMENTS COMMUNICATION MESSAGES

THE CLINTON ADMINISTRATION IS UNDERTAKING THIS TASK BECAUSE IT IS THE RIGHT THING TO DO.

If our review determines that American citizens were treated wrongfully by their own government during the Cold War, this Administration believes it owes the American people a full accounting and where justified, an attempt to right any wrong done to individuals. However, it is far too early to tell if this review will determine that compensation is warranted.

THIS HISTORIC EFFORT IS AN EXAMPLE OF THE CHANGE THE CLINTON ADMINISTRATION HAS BROUGHT TO WASHINGTON.

The review of human radiation experiments conducted during the Cold War is in line with several fundamental positions of the Clinton Administration:

REINVENTING GOVERNMENT

- This initiative will make records of government actions available to the public in a way that they can reasonably be studied, rather than ignored in obscure corners all over the country.
- The Reinventing Government Initiative specifically called for reducing classification of information and secrecy.
- Review of human experiments shows responsiveness to widespread public interest the subject and public desire that this period of our country's history be fully examined.

REDUCING SECRECY

- President Clinton has ordered government to reduce secrecy about past and current operations.

EARNING TRUST AND CREDIBILITY

- The Clinton Administration believes that the American people have a right to trust their government and trust can only be achieved if the government is open and truthful with the people.

CHANGE

- In the past, the government has been forced by Congress or citizen groups to examine the issue of experiments on humans. The response by previous administrations has been grudging and designed to down-play the issue. This is the first broad inquiry generated by the government itself.

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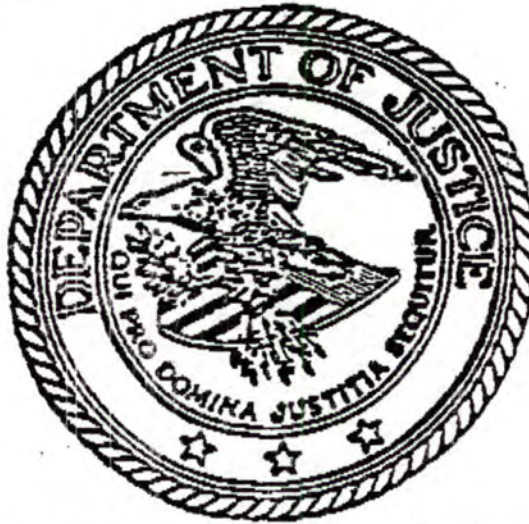
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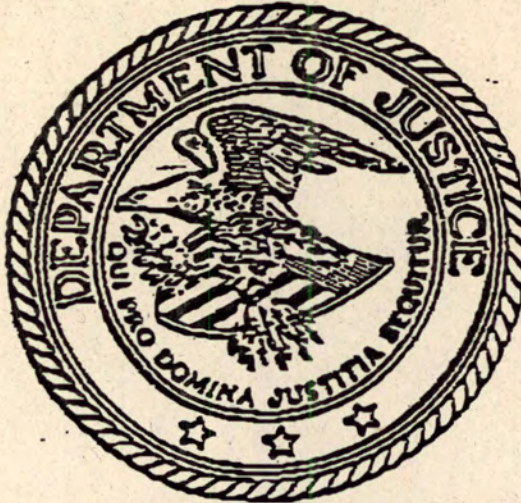

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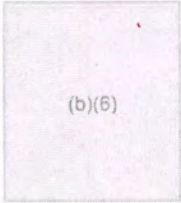
