SUBJECT: 1999 Women's World Cup Soccer Bid

Following the success of the 1994 Men's World Cup Soccer Tournament held in this country last summer, the U.S. Soccer Federation (USSF) has decided to bid on the 1999 Women's World Cup. The U.S. team won the inaugural Women's World Cup in 1991 in China, and finished third this summer at the competition in Sweden. If the U.S. wins the bid, the 1999 Women's World Cup will be held in several U.S. cities during the summer of 1999.

The USSF is the governing body for U.S. soccer and is the U.S. representative to FIFA, the international soccer federation. As with the 1994 World Cup, the Olympics, and other international sporting events, the host country must make certain government guarantees before the bid is submitted. Leon Panetta recently met with officials from the USSF and pledged that the Administration would fully support the USSF in its bid (letter attached).

The Federation must submit its bid to FIFA within several months. To that end, please come to a meeting on Thursday, October 5, 1995, at 4:00 pm in Room 180 OEOP to begin this process.

We are sending this note to the same staff that serve on the interagency committee established to coordinate 1996 Olympic activity. In doing so, we assume that the same people will be involved in this effort (although this will be much less of a time commitment in the short run). If this is not the case, please make sure the appropriate person from your agency comes to this meeting.

U.S. SOCCER FEDERATION LAUNCHES BID TO HOST 1999 WOMEN'S WORLD CUP

HELSINGBORG, Sweden (Friday, February 17, 1995) -- The United States Soccer Federation announced today its intention to submit a bid to the Federation Internationale de Football Association (FIFA), soccer's world governing body, to host the 1999 Women's World Cup.

The announcement was made by U.S. Soccer Federation Secretary General/Executive Director Hank Steinbrecher during proceedings of the 1995 Women's World Cup Draw. The U.S. Women's National Team won the inaugural world title in 1991 in China, and has qualified to defend its crown in Sweden June 5-18, 1995. The draw to determine the USA's first-round opponents will be conducted tomorrow.

U.S. Soccer has named campaign marketing consultant **Rey Post** as Managing Director of its bidding committee. Post served from 1987-1988 as the director of the successful 15-month U.S. Soccer bid to bring the 1994 World Cup to the United States, and later as a senior consultant to the World Cup 1994 Organizing Committee. Emilio Pozzi, who served as Executive Vice President of the Washington, D.C., World Cup Host Committee and holds the same post for the Washington Olympic '96 soccer venue, has been named Deputy Director of the 1999 bidding committee.

"On the heels of the success of the 1994 World Cup, and as we prepare to defend our women's world championship, as well as hosting both men and women's soccer matches at the 1996 Olympics, U.S. Soccer believes it is important to host international soccer events which can further contribute to our goal of making soccer a pre-eminent sport in the United States," Steinbrecher said.

U.S. Soccer officials will meet with FIFA representatives during the Women's World Cup Draw proceedings to discuss specific bid parameters and timelines.

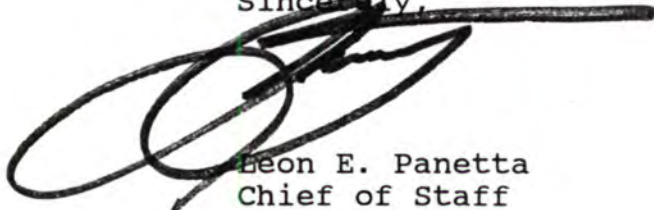

SUBJECT: 1999 Women's World Cup Soccer Bid

Following the success of the 1994 Men's World Cup Soccer Tournament held in this country last summer, the U.S. Soccer Federation (USSF) has decided to bid on the 1999 *Women's* World Cup. The U.S. team won the inaugural Women's World Cup in 1991 in China, and finished third this summer at the competition in Sweden. If the U.S. wins the bid, the 1999 Women's World Cup will be held in several U.S. cities during the summer of 1999.

The USSF is the governing body for U.S. soccer and is the U.S. representative to FIFA, the international soccer federation. As with the 1994 World Cup, the Olympics, and other international sporting events, the host country must make certain government guarantees before the bid is submitted. Leon Panetta recently met with officials from the USSF and pledged that the Administration would fully support the USSF in its bid (letter attached).

The Federation must submit its bid to FIFA within several months. To that end, please come to a meeting on Thursday, October 5, 1995, at 4:00 pm in Room 180 OEOP to begin this process.

We are sending this note to the same staff that serve on the interagency committee established to coordinate 1996 Olympic activity. In doing so, we assume that the same people will be involved in this effort (although this will be much less of a time commitment in the short run). If this is not the case, please make sure the appropriate person from your agency comes to this meeting.
