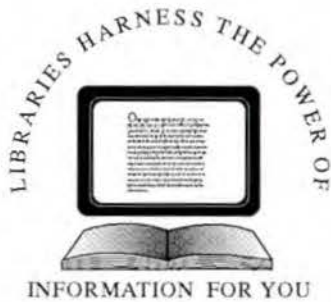

The president of an Omaha data company gave a \$ 100,000 campaign contribution in March to a committee affiliated with **Hillary Rodham Clinton's** Senate campaign, making him the single largest soft-money donor to Clinton, according to campaign-finance disclosures released yesterday.
