“RETURN TOAST” REMARKS BY PRIME MINISTER
AT THE BANQUET AT THE WHITE HOUSE
17th September, 2000

Your Excellency President Clinton and Mrs. Hillary Clinton,

Your Excellencies,

Distinguished Guests,

Colleagues,

I owe my presence here today principally to two persons, widely separated in time, as also in space: One, the explorer Christopher Columbus, who set sail to India but landed in America. I sometimes wonder where you would be, or where we would be if he had actually reached India! The other, to whom I owe a personal debt, is the President of the United States of America – William Jefferson Clinton. Had you, Mr President, not ‘rediscovered’ India, I would today not have the honour of enjoying your gracious hospitality, or replying to your most generous toast!

The light that radiates above our two nations, is of our respective struggles for freedom, for liberty, for individual excellence and enterprise. This today, brings us together as two great democracies.

Mr President, I have had a most memorable stay in your country. You constantly displayed touching personal solicitude. My delegation and I are enriched by your great warmth, and honoured by being feted by the American people. I am particularly grateful to Mrs. Clinton for have taken

the time out from the middle of an election campaign. As a parliamentarian of 40 years' standing and speaking from the experience of many elections, I applaud your presence here today. We are greatly moved, Mr President, by your joining me in the dedication of the memorial of Mahatma Gandhi in Washington. Trust me, the people of India shall always value this. This memorial, in the heart of your capital, is a profound symbol of the unity of values of our two societies.

The century that we leave behind saw many ideas compete for the soul of this world. We know today that it is the ideas of Gandhi and Woodrow Wilson that will triumph. We know, too, that America and India stand on the right side of history.

Mr President, it is a reflection of your statesmanship that you saw this simple truth. It is a testimony of your courage, and leadership, that you dared to cross the territory of doubts to reach out to the hearts of the Indian people. And, it is tribute to your efforts that the manner in which we approach each other, is being fundamentally transformed.

This year, our two nations reached out to each other as never before. It may have taken us fifty years to redeem the hope of a fruitful partnership that existed at the birth of independent India. But, we have, I believe, created a framework of dialogue and engagement that will stand the test of time.

I am delighted to share this evening with many people from India and the United States who have lent their enterprise, expertise and energy to

building a closer partnership between us. I salute you – Congressmen and the Senators, diplomats and officials, scientists and entrepreneurs, thinkers and scholars, academics and artists and this league of Americans of Indian heritage, for your goodwill and your efforts.

Excellencies, Ladies and Gentlemen, I would now like to invite you to raise a toast

- to the good health and well being of President Clinton and Mrs. Clinton.
- to the close and abiding friendship between our peoples.
- to the vision of this new relationship between India and the United States of America.

The draft press schedule for Sunday's dinner is attached. Please note a couple of things:

- 1) Your crew will be cleared in for 2:00 p.m. on Sunday to the NW gate of the White House. That gate is on Pennsylvania Avenue (which is closed to traffic); when you face the house, the gate is to your right. You'll need photo identification and your equipment will be swept by Secret Service upon entrance. Once you've been cleared through, proceed up the driveway (the one to your furthest right, past the television cameras) to the press briefing room (the door to your left when you face the West Wing portico). The guard can show you exactly where it is. Gayleen and Lissa will come to the briefing room around 2:30 p.m. for the press preview.
- 2) Our press coordinator, Gayleen Dalsimer, will be handling the press preview at 2:30 p.m. Lissa Muscatine, Mrs. Clinton's press secretary, will also be there. If you have any questions or problems in the afternoon, Gayleen can be reached at our main office number at 456-2960. She and Lissa also can be paged at 202/757-5000. Feel free to page me as well. I'll be in the office around 5:30 p.m.
- 3) Following the press preview at 2:30, your crew should wait in the press briefing room for a 3:00 call to pre-set at the South Portico for the arrival of the Prime Minister. They'll be joining other members of the President's press pool (and the foreign pool) for the set up. (Christine Anderson – who handles all the logistical movements for the president's pool – will most likely be the person taking the group over. We'll let her know you'll be joining them.). Following set up, your crew can leave the White House until 6:00 or so. We'll make sure they're cleared in again for 6:00 p.m.
- 4) Disregard notes about the "IN HOUSE PRESS POOL AND INDIAN PRESS POOL ONLY" – we have you integrated into our social pool and you'll have access to all of these events.

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- The President and Mrs. Clinton are hosting His Excellency Atal Bihari Vajpayee, Prime Minister of the Republic of India at a White House Official Dinner on Sunday, September 17, 2000. The Prime Minister will arrive at the South Portico at 6:45 p.m.

The President and Mrs. Clinton will escort His Excellency to the Pavilion on the lower South Grounds of the White House for dinner.

The tables in the South Lawn Pavilion will be set with gold base plates; cream china will be used for service. Gold flatware will be set on pomegranate bonaventure damask tablecloths. Gold hurricane candles will adorn each table, surrounded by an abundance of fall fruits--grapes, lychee nuts, pomegranate and pears--and wartah protea, ambience and message roses, hydrangea, bromeliad stems and pepperberry. Crystal votive candles complete the centerpieces.

Following the dinner, guests will be entertained in the South Lawn Pavilion by the Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center.

The President and Mrs. Clinton are pleased to welcome back to the White House the Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center. As the nation's premier repertory company for chamber music, the Society strives to bring audiences the finest performances of an extraordinary repertoire, which features works spanning from the Renaissance to contemporary times. OFFICIAL GIFTS

PRESIDENT CLINTON'S GIFT TO HIS EXCELLENCY ATAL BIHARI VAJPAYEE, PRIME MINISTER OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDIA

On the occasion of his Official Visit to Washington, D.C., President Clinton presents to Prime Minister Vajpayee a Tiffany's hand-crafted sterling silver cache pot with an engraved inscription. The flower in the center is a dogwood blossom, a tree frequently found in the President's home state of Arkansas. The Presidential Seal is engraved on the bottom of the Tiffany silver piece.

The cache pot was designed exclusively as a gift for President Clinton to present on the occasion of an official visit. Every American president has had a signature gift to give during his tenure.

OFFICIAL DELEGATION GIFT:

The official gift for members of the Indian delegation is a Gray Hawn Watercolor Portrait with an inscription commemorating the Official Visit to Washington of the Prime Minister of Republic of India. Each print is a painterly image that is one of a kind.

PRIME MINISTER VAJPAYEE'S GIFT TO THE PRESIDENT:

The Prime Minister of the Republic of India will present to President Clinton a "Revered Image in Glass". Anjolie Ela Menon (born 1940), one of the foremost artists of our time, has created the glass sculpture of Ganesha, as part of a special series. Lord Ganesha heralds prosperity and success. All auspicious rites and undertakings start with homage to Ganesha, the remover of obstacles and the deity of good fortune and success. The form of Ganesha is an artist's delight and is used extensively in Indian Art.

The Prime Minister of the Republic of India will present to Mrs. Clinton a diamond bracelet.

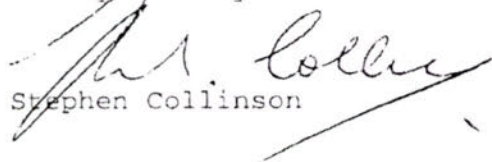
