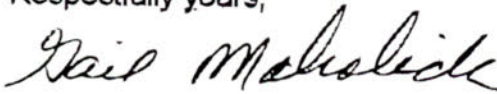

It turns out that it will just be me for Wednesday. But my newspaper is planning to send a photographer with me on Monday for the unveiling of the White House Christmas decorations.

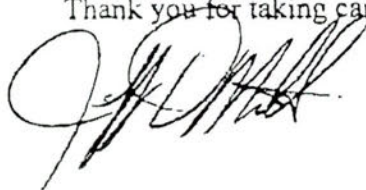
