THE PRESIDENT AND MRS. CLINTON HONOR THE
PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA AND MRS. KIM
AT OFFICIAL WHITE HOUSE DINNER

WASHINGTON, DC -- The President and Mrs. Clinton are hosting the President of the Republic of Korea and Mrs. Kim at an official White House dinner on Tuesday, November 23. Guests will begin arriving at the East Executive Entrance of the White House at 7:15 PM.

The 140 guests will be seated in the State Dining Room. The tables will be set with the Reagan China and a russet damask table skirt. The floral center pieces will be arranged atop 30 inch brass and crystal candelabras with four 24 inch cream tapers. The floral design includes the use of a variety of four roses - Harmony, Mercedes, Oceanna and Coral, accented by Euphorbia, Gerber Daisies, and ivy.

Following dinner, the guests will be entertained by Miss Jessye Norman in the East Room. Miss Norman will perform "Falling In Love" written by Rogers and Hart, "Lonely Town" written by Leonard Bernstein, "Somewhere" written by Leonard Bernstein, "Our Love Is Her To Stay" written by Ira Gershwin, and "Luck To Be Me" written by Leonard Bernstein. Miss Norman will be accompanied on the piano by Mr. Marvin Laird.

At the conclusion of the entertainment, President and Mrs. Clinton will escort the Kims to the North Portico for their departure.

WASHINGTON, DC -- The President and Mrs. Clinton are hosting His Excellency Fernando Henrique Cardoso, President of the Federative Republic of Brazil and Mrs. Ruth Cardoso at a White House State Dinner on Thursday, April 20, 1995. The black tie dinner will begin at 7:15 PM with the arrival of His Excellency President Cardoso and Mrs. Cardoso at the White House North Portico. Dinner guests will begin to arrive at 7:00 PM.

Guests will be received by the President and Mrs. Clinton, and President Cardoso and Mrs. Cardoso in the Grand Foyer of the White House. Following the receiving line, the President and Mrs. Clinton will escort President Cardoso and Mrs. Cardoso into the State Dining Room.

The tables in the State Dining Room will be set with alternating Eisenhower gold base plates, and the Blair House gold and white lattice work base plates; the Regan red China will be used for service; gilded flatware; and Morgantown crystal on a garden rose damask table cloth. The floral center pieces feature rose colored peonies, cherry blossoms, cream roses and ivy atop 32 inch crystal and gold topiary containers. The arrangements are complemented by four elevated crystal hurricane globes with votive candles.

Following the dinner, guests will be entertained by the internationally acclaimed jazz musicians Ramsey Lewis and Billy Taylor.

At the conclusion of the entertainment, the President and Mrs. Clinton will escort President Cardoso and Mrs. Cardoso to the North portico for their departure. Guests will be invited to continue the evening with dancing in the Grand Foyer.
