HOST DELLA REESE AND LEGEND B.B. KING TURN THE WHITE HOUSE BLUE

— *South Lawn Setting For A High-Definition Special Of High-Spirited Blues* —

Washington, D.C. — President and Mrs. Clinton welcome host **Della Reese**, legendary artist **B.B. King**, blues prodigy **Jonny Lang**, Piedmont blues duo **John Cephas & Phil Wiggins**, and powerhouse piano player **Marcia Ball** to "**Legends of the Blues: In Performance at the White House**" (wt), to be taped in high-definition (HD) on July 28th before an invited audience on the South Lawn of the White House. The one-hour special will air nationwide on PBS (airdate and time TBA).

This is the second in the series of "**In Performance**" specials that WETA, in association with NHK, Japan Broadcasting Corporation, has produced in HD at the White House. WETA and NHK taped the first ever HDTV at the White House with "**The Singer and the Song**," which airs on PBS Wednesday, September 1, at 8 p.m. Celebrating the vibrancy and richness of American culture, "**In Performance at the White House**" is funded by Ameritech and produced by WETA Washington, D.C.

Born in Detroit, Della Reese began singing at age six. Her break came in the 1950s, when she turned from gospel to blues and scored her first hit with "And That Reminds Me (Of You)." Numerous recordings and appearances followed. Now best known for her role on the television series "Touched by An Angel," Reese continues to perform between her busy television taping schedule.

Riley B. King (B.B. King) was born in 1925 on a cotton plantation in Itta Bene, Mississippi. King started out to be a gospel singer and at 12 years old bought his first guitar, a little red Stella with a "big hole in the center." In 1947 King hitchhiked to Memphis with his guitar and \$2.50 in his pocket to pursue his musical career. He started recording in the late 1940s and the rest is blues history.

King's guitar-playing technique mixes traditional blues, jazz, swing, mainstream pop and jump into a unique sound. King has released over 50 albums and has had two number one R & B hits. He has received eight Grammy Awards, as well as many other honors throughout his career. His influence has touched many

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musicians, including rock artists Eric Clapton and Jimi Hendrix, and he now comes to the White House to share his legacy of the blues.

Blues prodigy Jonny Lang was born in Fargo, North Dakota in 1981. Like King he was moved by the sound of the blues at an early age. Beginning in 1997, at just 16, Lang toured extensively, making headline appearances in clubs and Hard Rock Cafes across the country. Word spread of his immense talent, and two critically acclaimed albums followed. He recently spent a month on the road with King, an experience that clearly had an impact; he compared performing with King to standing beside a god.

The award-winning music of Cephas & Wiggins has been described as "traditional Piedmont blues." Their distinctive sound has won the hearts of both traditional and contemporary blues fans alike. John Cephas and Phil Wiggins were both born in Washington, D.C., and in 1976 they began their successful collaboration. Cephas's masterful guitar work and Wiggins's soulful harmonica have earned them numerous honors, including a W.C. Handy Award for Best Traditional Blues Performance.

Blues pianist Marcia Ball grew up in the small town of Vinton, Louisiana, near the Texas border. In the late 1970s Ball moved to Austin where she became an important and popular figure on the city's music scene as both a leader of a band and as a solo performer. She is a recipient of the 1998 W.C. Handy Award for Contemporary Female Vocalist of the Year.

B.B. King

For more than half a century, B.B. King has been among the most popular and influential artists in American music. He has been singing and playing the blues in his own unique style since his birth in the Mississippi Delta in 1925. He used to play on street corners for his supper, and later would appear at up to four Delta blues clubs on a given Saturday night. His break came in Memphis, the cradle of many a stellar black blues artist, when he secured live performance spots on various radio stations. It was also here that King, born Riley B. King, adopted the moniker B.B.; he was looking for a catchy radio name, and Beale Street Blues Boy was eventually shortened to Blues Boy and then, simply B.B. By any name, the music is the key to King's success. He has recorded more than 50 albums, among them 1965's "Live at the Regal," still considered the definitive live blues album. King has had two No. 1 R & B hits, 1951's "Three O'Clock Blues" and 1952's "You Don't Know Me." In 1970 he proved he could crossover to reach a wider audience, when his hit "The Thrill is Gone" reached No. 15 on the pop charts. Some of his most colorful and revered compositions, like "Payin' the Cost to be the Boss," are considered blues staples. He has won eight Grammys (out of 20 nominations), and been inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. B.B.'s influence is evidenced by his having been granted four honorary doctorates and a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Grammys. Yet his true influence is found in the guitar greats of various genres who cite King as a major influence and inspiration, among them Eric Clapton and the late Jimi Hendrix. B.B. King is an American treasure, and one of the most honored musicians of all-time.

Jonny Lang

Influenced by the blues legends of the past yet with a vision all his own, Jonny Lang is indeed a blues prodigy. Born in Fargo, North Dakota in 1981, he was moved by the sound of the blues at an early age. He attended his first live concert at 12 and watched from the crowd as Ted Larsen (lead guitarist for the Bad Medicine Blues Band) played the blues. Larsen's guitar moves left such an indelible impression on Lang, that eventually Larsen and Lang became mentor and student. Lang soon joined the group, became the frontman and under the band's new name of Kid Johnny Lang & the Big Bang, began his blues career. Beginning in 1997, at just 16, Lang toured extensively making headline appearances in clubs and Hard Rock Cafes across the country. Since the release of his first album, "Lie to Me," Lang has toured with such acts as The Rolling Stones, Aerosmith and blues legend B.B. King. His second album, "Wander This World," displays his talent for playing blues with a more R&B flavor, as well as demonstrating his soulful vocal talents. The late blues great Luther Allison said of Lang, "He has the power to move the music into the next millennium by reaching the ears of a new generation." Still a teenager, Lang is doing just that.

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Cephas & Wiggins

The award-winning duo of Cephas & Wiggins put the gritty, moving sound of traditional acoustic blues front and center. John Cephas and Phil Wiggins were both born in Washington, D.C., and first joined forces in 1976. Cephas's first taste in music, like B.B. King's, was gospel, but after learning to play guitar in a manner that is reminiscent of the Piedmont blues, he soon perfected his intricate and skillful guitar work to become one of the country's best traditional blues musicians. Phil Wiggins began his musical career with some of Washington D.C.'s leading blues artists and developed his unique harmonica sound by listening to and studying the works of blues pianists and horn players, most notably Sonny Boy Williamson, Little Walter and Junior Wells. In addition to being a renowned harmonica player, Wiggins is also a gifted songwriter and singer whose material has helped to define the duo's unique sound. Their 1987 album, "Dog Days of August," won a W.C. Handy Award for Best Traditional Blues Performance. Cephas & Wiggins are also very active in the blues community, conducting workshops and sparking new interest in their chosen genre, traditional country blues. As Cephas puts it "I would like to see a revival of country blues by more young people. That's why I stay in the field of traditional music. I don't want to see it die."

Marcia Ball

Blues pianist Marcia Ball grew up in the small town of Vinton, Louisiana but it was in the music mecca of Austin, Texas that she first made her mark. In the late 1970s she became an important and popular figure on the Austin scene as both a leader of a band and as a solo performer. Ball signed her first record deal in 1978 and by the early 80's had perfected her own piano stylings of Gulf Coast rhythm and blues. Since then Ball has released many critically acclaimed recordings as both a solo artist and a collaborator. She has appeared at most major festivals throughout the United States and Europe. She is a recipient of the 1998 W.C. Handy Award for Contemporary Female Vocalist of the Year and was nominated again this year in the category of Blues Instrumentalist-Keyboards. She has also been nominated for a Grammy for her album "Sing It!," recorded with fellow "blues divas" Tracey Nelson and Irma Thomas.
