Pool Spray Points

- I've come here on behalf of the American people to pay tribute to an extraordinary woman, a fighter for Israel and for peace.
- Don't believe it is appropriate in this context for me to comment on the situation today, but I do want to express America's solidarity with the people of Israel at this difficult time.
- What's critical now is to end the violence and to move on with peace, to fulfill Yitzakh's and Leah's vision of a secure Israel at peace.

If asked who is responsible for the violence or any question about peace process

- As I said, I am here to represent the American people and pay our respects to Leah Rabin. This is not the time for me to say more. But our hearts and prayers are with the people of Israel.

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MEMORANDUM TO: THE FIRST LADY

SUBJECT: Your Visit to Israel/Leah Rabin's Funeral

Background: Since September 28th, Israelis and Palestinians have experienced the worst outbreak of violence since the Intifada. So far, roughly 200 people have been killed and thousands wounded, the overwhelming majority of them Palestinian. The violence is fueled by a vicious cycle that is very hard to break: Arafat is either unwilling or unable to stop the violence; and Barak is under great pressure to respond with what appears to many to be excessive force. The funerals, in turn, fuel more violence.

Three sets of negotiations (in Paris, with Secretary Albright; in Sharm el-Sheikh, with the President; and in Israel with former Prime Minister Peres) have failed to change the situation on the ground. Tension remains high as Palestinian night-time shootings continue; Barak is maintaining Israel's economic stranglehold on the Palestinian Authority (e.g., through closures or withholding tax revenue); and strong Israeli responses to Palestinian demonstrators guarantee a steady flow of funerals. Recent days have seen the crossing of several redlines (e.g., the shooting by Palestinians of Israeli settlers; the deliberate targeting of Palestinian leaders by Israeli forces) with a very serious risk that things will get completely out of control. We are only one tragedy (a successful terrorist operation; an Israeli attack that mistakenly results in large casualties) away from a full-blown confrontation.

POTUS meeting with Arafat and Barak: In his meetings with Chairman Arafat and Prime Minister Barak last week, the President focused on the need for both sides to implement the commitments they undertook at Sharm. Arafat made clear he is ready to return to the peace process as soon as possible; Barak said he could not do so as long as the violence continues. While there may be one last opportunity to reach some kind of agreement between the two sides (whether a comprehensive agreement or some intermediary form) before the end of the Administration, this opportunity risks slipping absent a significant change on the ground.

Your Meeting with President Katsav: Moshe Katsav was sworn in as Israel's eighth president on August 1, 2000. On assuming office, Katsav declared he would seek to bring unity to a

divided Israeli society by building bridges between the varying religious, social and economic sectors. During his early days as president, Katsav hosted a dialogue on unity between reform and orthodox rabbis. While he has received some criticism in the press for his statements on the importance of religion in Israeli society (Katsav is an observant Jew) and for his comments on the importance of Jews in the diaspora making *aliya* (emigrating to Israel), in general, the first 100 days of the Katsav Presidency have been significantly less controversial than was the norm under his outspoken predecessor Ezer Weizman.

A longtime Likud Knesset member, Katsav served in seven Knessets in a variety of positions, including Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Tourism, Minister of Transport, Minister of Labor and Social Welfare, and Minister for Arab Affairs, as well as head of the Likud Knesset Faction. He is a former mayor of Kiryat Malachi, his hometown near the city of Ashdod. He has a background in economics and history. Katsav was born in Iran in 1945 and came to Israel in 1951. He is married with five children. He speaks Hebrew, English, Persian and Arabic.

LEAH RABIN
1928-2000

- Born Leah Shlossberg in Germany -- family left Germany for Palestine the day after Hitler came to power in 1933. First met Yitzchak Rabin as a teenager.
- Joined the Palmach Pre-state Jewish military underground forces and served in Yitzchak Rabin's battalion.
- Married Yitzchak Rabin on August 23, 1948 -- just a little over three months after the declaration of the State of Israel.
- Devoted her life to her role as Rabin's wife, mother of his children and after his death to commemorating his life and his work for peace. Survived by her children Dalia and Yuval and four grandchildren the youngest of whom -- a girl -- was born Monday (November 13) to Yuval and his wife Tali, in the States.
- Was always there for Rabin during his service as soldier, Chief of Staff, Ambassador to Washington, Cabinet member, Defense Minister, and Prime Minister.
- Famous for her love of life, her ability to produce dinner for 50 and a magnificent table . . . without help . . . active in the cause of autistic children -- President of Israel's Association for Autistic Children since 1974.
- During Yitzchak Rabin's lifetime Leah Rabin was in her own words and in the title of her memoirs, "Always His Wife"; but she was also her own woman: outspoken and indefatigable in her support of Rabin's memory and his work for peace . . . unforgiving of those who opposed that legacy; a good friend to those she loved.
- After her husband's assassination Leah devoted her time to traveling to promote the peace process which she considered to be her husband's greatest legacy. Will always be remembered even by her critics for her indubitable strength in the aftermath of her husband's assassination . . . for her direct contact with Israeli youth and her encouragement of the peace camp in Israel in the face of much opposition.

- Her final battle was with lung cancer. . . which was diagnosed a year ago in an advanced stage . . . she fought it as she fought all her enemies, with courage -- until pneumonia weakened her and her heart gave out.
- It was Leah Rabin who asked Hillary Clinton to deliver the Rabin Memorial Address and she did so exactly a year ago in Tel Aviv.
- Hillary Clinton spoke with Leah Rabin only a week ago on election day in the United States. She phoned Leah Rabin who expressed amazement that the First Lady had time to call her at the height of the New York Senatorial race in which she was a candidate. Leah Rabin, who was already very weak, wished her luck.
- Hillary Clinton has visited Israel five times as private citizen, tourist and pilgrim. Her sixth visit is to honor the memory of Leah Rabin.

Talking Points

- Congratulations on your election as Israel's President.
- President Clinton asked me to convey to you his greetings and best wishes, and to assure you of the United States' unshakable friendship and support for Israel.
- Even though the United States is still waiting to find out who our next President will be, I know that both Vice President Gore and Governor Bush share a common dedication to the U.S.-Israel relationship.
- I know that even though many political commentators thought the vote in the Knesset would go against you, you were always convinced that you would win.
- Having just completed my first run for elective office, I would be interested in knowing what made you so confident you would carry the day?
- We in the United States have been following events in Israel and the territories closely ever since the end of September.
- I would be interested in your views on the situation, and especially on the difficulties between Arab and Jewish Israelis in northern Israel.
- How do you think Israel's leaders will deal with the tension and what caused it in the Galilee? What will be your role as President?

(If asked about Katsav travelling to the United States before January 20 to meet the President.)

- I'm sure the President would be very interested if your respective schedules permitted it. The next several months will be very busy for both of you. I'll pass on your message when I see the President in Vietnam later this week.

(If asked about Jonathan Pollard. President Katsav sent a letter to the President recently asking that he consider releasing Pollard.)

- The President knows how much you are interested in the Pollard case. As he promised, he is reviewing the case.
