WASHINGTON, D.C. -- On Saturday, June 17, 2000, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton will tour Val Kill Cottage, the Hyde Park, N.Y., home of Eleanor Roosevelt. Mrs. Clinton's visit is part of the ongoing "Save America's Treasures" program, an effort to preserve the nation's most historic—and threatened—landmarks. Mrs. Clinton will tour the cottage and announce an important donation to help preserve the national historic site.

Save America's Treasures is a public-private partnership of the White House Millennium Council and the National Trust for Historic Preservation. As honorary chair of the Save America's Treasures Program, the First Lady has visited more than 40 historic and cultural sites around the country.
