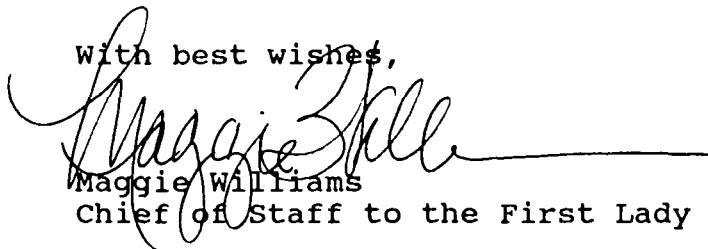
Dear Nneka:
