SUBJECT: Guidelines for Expenditures of Entertainment Fund

Each year, a small fund is appropriated to the White House Office for official entertainment expenses. For your information, \$20,000 was appropriated for fiscal year 1993. Government regulations require that the following criteria be met when expending these funds:

- The entertainment will further a valid function of the White House Office; and
- The function could not be accomplished as effectively from the Government's standpoint without the expenditure.

Within these broad guidelines, more specific rules apply:

- Entertainment funds are intended for the benefit of non-Government guests only. The fund may not be used to pay for meals, tickets, or other entertainment costs for Government officers and employees.
- Entertainment funds may not be used for gifts, employee birthday parties, staff parties, or holiday receptions, etc. Entertainment funds may not be used to pay for political events.
- When use of entertainment funds is appropriate, this Administration's commitment to reduce Government spending should be remembered. Efforts should be made to minimize meeting or reception costs by considering the food and/or beverages costs. Also, serving coffee and danish at a breakfast meeting is as good as a working luncheon.

To request use of the Entertainment Fund, the following procedures must be followed:

- At least 48 hours in advance, your office notifies the Staff Mess of the function, estimated date of the function, and the food and/or beverage that may be required.
- The Staff Mess will provide a verbal cost estimate and forward a written estimate to the White House Administrative Office for review. If the charges are reasonable, this office will authorize the Staff Mess to proceed with the function.

WHITE HOUSE STAFF MESS

The White House Staff Mess is located in the West Wing of the White House and provides meal service as a convenience to personnel whose offices are located in the residence, west and east wings of the White House, as well as for cabinet members, commissioned officers and White House Military Office unit commanders (Sitroom and PPD personnel are authorized carry-out service only).

DEPOSIT

A refundable deposit of \$100.00, payable to White House Staff Mess, is required prior to using the Mess. Membership accounts may be established in the OEOB Room 404. The deposit will be returned after termination of your membership and closure of your account.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Monday through Friday

BREAKFAST	-	7:00am - 9:00am
LUNCH		
(1st sitting)	-	12:00pm - 1:00pm
(2nd sitting)	-	1:15pm - 2:15pm
(carry-out)	-	11:30am - 2:00pm

Evening carry-out meal service is available from 5:30pm to 8:30pm, Monday through Friday.

Carry-out service is also available on Saturdays from 11:30am to 2:00pm for lunch. Breakfast and evening meal service is not available.

The Mess is closed on Sundays and holidays.

RESERVATIONS

Although reservations are not required, they are recommended for those members that desire to dine with guests. Members are responsible for all charges incurred by their guests. Reservations may be made by calling the Staff Mess on extension 6377. As a courtesy to all members, reservations will be held no more than 10 minutes.

Since guests may be in a position to overhear conversations which should not be public knowledge, members are urged to use discretion in inviting guests to the mess and to refrain from discussing classified information. For this reason, members of the press and foreign diplomatic corps may not dine in the Staff Mess.

CATERING

Catering service is available for special events held within the White House complex. For further information, call the Mess office at extension 4192.

BILLING

Prior to the 10th of each month, a bill will be sent to your office for the previous month's charges. Payment should be made by personal check, made payable to the White House Staff Mess and forwarded to the Staff Mess Office in Room 404 OEOB. PLEASE DO NOT SEND CASH. Members are required to pay mess bills in full within 10 days of receipt. Members who have not paid their bill within 30 days from the date of billing shall have their mess privileges terminated, and the required deposit shall be applied to the outstanding balance. Members whose privileges have been revoked may have them reinstated by paying the account in full, plus a deposit in the amount of \$200.00.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Dining room service is extended to all members equally, regardless of position.
- Carry-out food may not be brought into the dining rooms.
- Due to limited seating capacity, only dining room #3 (maximum capacity 16) is available for private dining of large parties.
- There may be occasions when Staff Mess personnel are required to provide meal service for other functions. During this period, meal service will be available to mess members only (no guests will be allowed).

With your cooperation, we will be able to provide excellent food service in a pleasant atmosphere and convenient location. Any suggestions which will help improve this service should be directed to Lieutenant Michael Lucas, Food Service Coordinator, at extension 4192, or visit his office in Room 404 OEOB.
