Dear Hillary Rodham Clinton,

Having been someone who has never written to a politician and considers myself rather unpolitical by nature, I presume that you personally will not be reading this. However, I do hope that my message is transmitted to you.

I am a year older than you - part of the sixties generation and probably have shared a similar experiential evolution from what I can glean from NYTimes article - today's magazine section. From simple traditional Catholic Background - I went the VISTA - social work route to find myself today - A Doctor in counseling psychology juggling a family of three sons, (ages 14 - and 12 yr old twins) a Wall Street exec husband and a private counseling practice. We can most closely be categorized as part of the "affluent parent" population which you refer to in today's article.

I am moved to write to simply affirm you in your convictions of the need of each of us to have the courage to assume the role of parents to our children. It frightens me in both my professional but even, more so

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personal circles to observe the hesitancy that abounds in this area - the language that has developed to justify that hesitancy eg describing 10 & 11 year olds as "mature, responsible, independent" beings when, in fact, one is entrusting them with responsibilities inappropriate to their young age. I'm struck by the defensiveness that exists particularly among the more educated, affluent population who choose to acknowledge and perhaps even vocalize 'parenting' as a valued priority in their lives.

I hope and trust that you will continue to wrestle with the difficulties of articulating your solid valuable convictions. You are right - the ills of our society - although they have assumed profound proportions - need to be addressed in the most basic way, within each of us, on a humanistic interpersonal level.

You have reaffirmed me for today.. I hope I have reaffirmed you.
