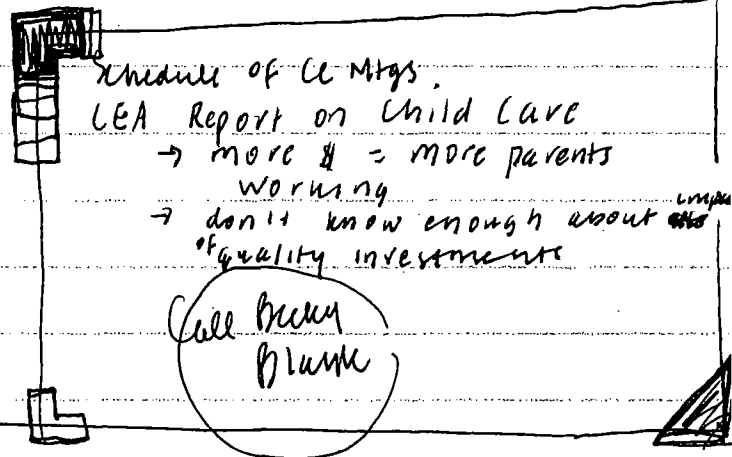

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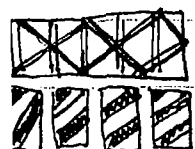

(2) Allow 6 mos only for pregnancy or
adoption

(3) Have to give longer notice
