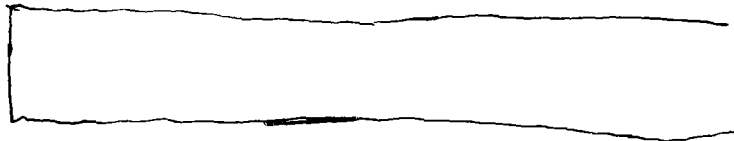

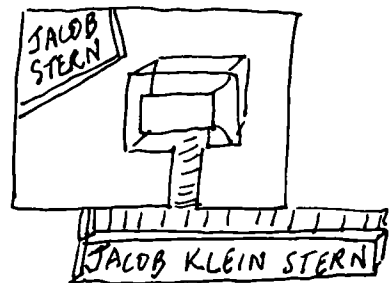

- ① Schools -- have to apply for snacks separately
§ 3 of HR 3086 -- Woolsey bill corrects this
- ② Snacks since 1981 only go to children up to age 13. Used to go to age 18. \$40-48M per year
Needs to move along with after-school programs.
Still means tested. Needs to be a program
- ③ For profit programs should be able to get food program. Shouldn't be linked to Title XX
\$50M/yr
