Child Care and Early Learning in the States

State	Governor	Program
North Carolina	Governor Jim Hunt	Smart Start: Early Learning/Child Care Through Smart Start, children gain access to higher quality and affordable child care, health care, and other services, during the most critical years of their development.
Colorado	Roy Roemer	Early Learning: Bright Beginnings: A private sector, volunteer-based effort that supports concrete actions that individuals, communities and businesses can take to enhance the security, stimulation, and nurturing of children in the most critical period of development -- from before birth to age three . Its purpose is to help change the way Coloradans think and act on behalf of young children and to make the state the best place to raise a child.
New Jersey	Christine Todd Whitman	Early Learning: Bright Beginnings: On April 24, 1997, Governor Whitman announced the program, an \$8.5 million early childhood initiative. Its goal is to increase the quality and quantity of child care in New Jersey. Bright Beginnings will help ensure that the child infrastructure of child care is available to meet the needs of mothers and infants and toddlers participating in the Governor's welfare reform program, Work First New Jersey.
Rhode Island	Lincoln Almond	Early Learning/Child Care Child Opportunity Zone Family Center Initiative: The Child Opportunity Zone (COZ) Family Center Initiative is a statewide partnership to build local capacity in communities to support children and families. Partners work together to create quality and integrated services that result in children coming to school ready to learn. The initiative includes improvements in the quality of care, health linkages, and home visits

Minnesota	Arne Carlson	Early Learning Early Childhood Family Education Infant Development Grants: This program, passed by the state legislature and signed into law by Governor Carlson, allocates \$2 million to fund parent mentoring programs to help that focus on methods and information that stimulate and nurture the intellectual and emotional development of infants.
West Virginia	Governor Cecil Underwood	Early Learning: Creating Starting Points Early Childhood Centers to serve families with young children in their communities. These centers provide services such as developmental screening and referral, parent and pre-school education such as Head Start, and home-based outreach.
Vermont	Howard Dean	Early Learning/Child Care: Success by Six: This initiative seeks to ensure that children are ready for school, through welcome baby visits, a family literacy program and child care quality enhancements.
Washington	Current Governor is Gary Locke, not sure whether he's a champion of the specific program.	Early Learning Early Childhood Education and Assistance: This program serves low-income four year old children through a early education, health screenings, parental involvement, and family support.
Indiana	Frank O'Bannon	Child Care/Early Learning Indiana Child Care Fund: This initiative will distribute child care "tool kits." These information packets will help community planners outline how family-friendly efforts including child care support can make a business more productive. In addition, the initiative will fund TEACH (Teacher Education and Compensation Helps), which will improve the caliber of child care by providing scholarship opportunities for those who work in a variety of child care settings.

Ohio	George Voinavich	Early Learning Ohio Early Start: This programs seeks to identify infants and toddlers who are at risk of abuse, neglect, or developmental delay, develop linkages to existing services and support new services, such as home visiting, parental education, and health screening.
Florida	Lawton Chiles	Child Care Child Care Executive Partnership: This program is a financing strategy that creates public-private partnerships to provide child care subsidies for the working poor. Under this initiative, Florida offers incentives to employers by providing matching fund to pay for part of the cost of child care for employees who are eligible for state-subsidized care.
Maryland	Parris Glendenning (Did not start this program)	Child Care Child Care Facilities Direct Loan: This program uses funds appropriated by the legislature to make loans at or below the prime lending rate. Loans with repayment schedules of up to twenty years may be secured for up to 50% of the cost of building or renovating a child care facility.
Illinois	Jim Edgar	Child Care On July 1, 1997, Illinois implemented a new child care system for all working families based on income. The program combines parent copayment and available state and federal funds to serve all working families with incomes below 50% of state median income. The program provides more child care in the most equitable and efficient manner. It is believed that this new system will eliminate waiting lists and the inequities of time limits on welfare assistance.

SUBJECT: Congressional Child Care Contacts

Pursuant to our meeting last week, below is an outline of Congressional members and/or staff with whom we should have contact regarding child care over the next month. As you can see, I've put them into two categories - child care leaders and potential leaders or supporters. In addition to these groups, we need to reach out to the leadership of both parties as well as the potential critics of our child care initiative. It would be most helpful to meet or talk again soon to map all this out.

Child Care Leaders -- These are the members/staff who already have staked out leadership positions on child care.

Kerry - David Kass: I've talked to David several times, Bruce has met with David, and the Senator has met with the President and Raines. I think we know what they'd like to see in our proposal.

Kennedy - Stephanie Robinson I've met and talked with Stephanie on several occasions. Their child care/early childhood development plan is laid out in their tobacco bill and they very much want WH to acknowledge link between tobacco \$'s and investment in children. They are also part of Dodd group and co-sponsors of Kerry bill. Contact by WH would be useful.

Dodd - Jeanne Ireland As Dodd announced at our CC Conference lunch, they have brought a bipartisan Senate staff group together to try to nail down a bipartisan child care bill **before** SOU. I've met with Jeanne and, among other things, advised her that Admin will want Dodd's support for our initiative so he shouldn't

box himself out of doing so in advance. More WH contact on this point would be most useful.

Kohl - Julie Cohen

Strong supporter of tax credit approach. I've not met with staff, but assume that Treasury has been in touch. We need to contact.

Harkin - Bev Shroeder

Given his L/HHS position, always a key player on child care and part of Dodd group. I've not been in contact with them.

Jeffords - Kimberly Barnes
O'Connor

I've met with her and will stay in close touch. Jeffords has own bill and is part of Dodd group. I specifically asked if they wanted anything special from us or WH at this time, but didn't have any requests.

* Hatch - Kris Iverson/Judy Hill

Hatch has long history of support of child care (with Kennedy and Dodd), and staff is part of Dodd group. I've not met with them yet.

Bond - Shawn Gilleylen

Co-sponsor of Kerry bill and thus key player on child care. I've not met with their staff.

Snowe - Cynthia Daillard

Long-time child care leader, lead sponsor on refundable tax credit bill, part of Dodd group. Offended by lack of role in WH conference. Have not met with them yet.

Specter - Ali Dekosky

Part of Dodd group, has employer tax credit bill and key player given L/HHS chair.

DeLauro - Catrina MacDonald

Active child care and early childhood development leader in House and sponsor of Kerry companion bill. I talk to staff regularly. WH contact would be useful.

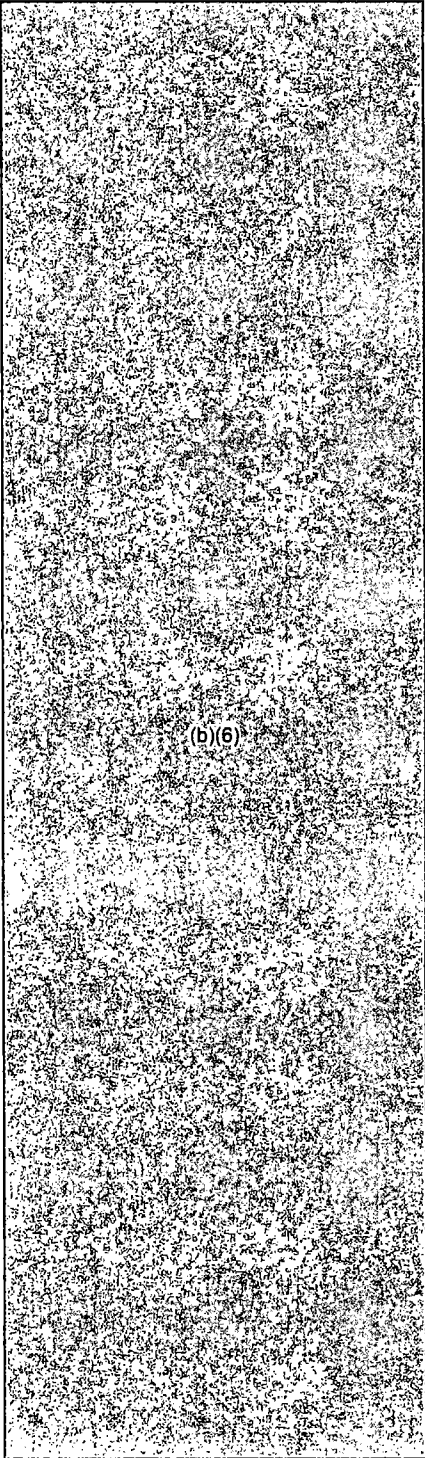

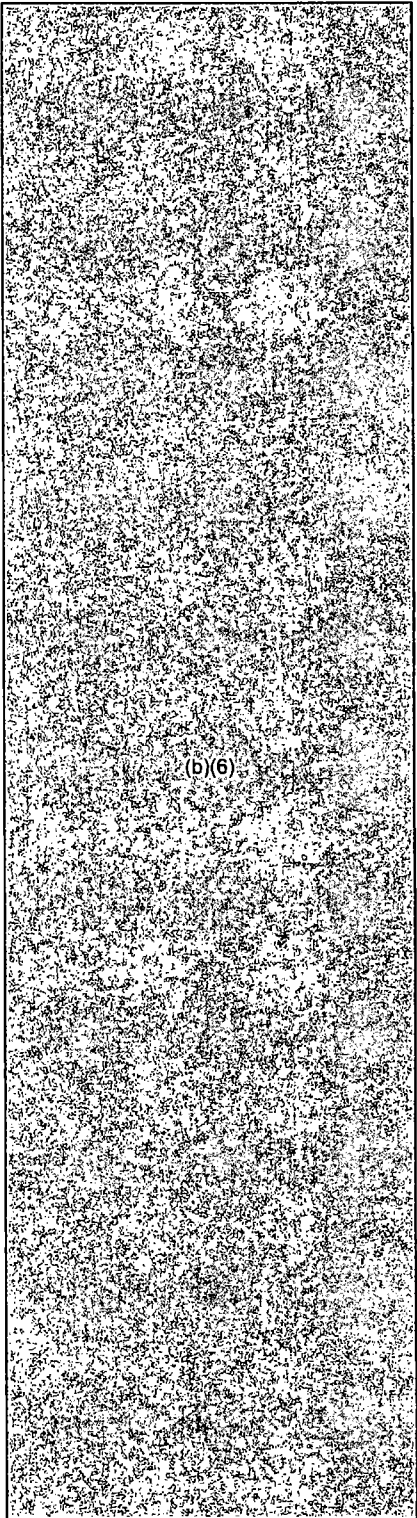

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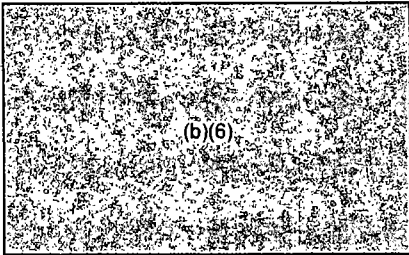
