Dear Mr. McCann:

This note is to clarify the illustrative nature of the State-by-State allocation tables for the Child Care Initiative that are included in the Congressional Justifications (CJ) for the Administration for Children and Families. These tables include State breakouts of the proposed increase in the Child Care Entitlement section of the CJ (Child Care Subsidy Supplement, Special Match and the Early Learning Fund) and in the Child Care and Development Block Grant section (Standards Enforcement Fund and Child Care Provider Scholarship Fund).

These tables were meant to be illustrative only, and do not indicate the actual distribution of funds across States. We look forward to working with Congress to determine the best method of allocating funds and the appropriate set asides for each fund.

We regret not labeling these tables as illustrative and apologize for any confusion this may have caused.
