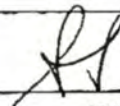

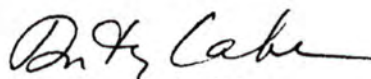

Thanks for the opportunity to come down and chat last Thurs. I hope my explanation of our positions was adequate.

However, I did leave out one critical thought in relation to the issue of "seek to, where feasible, consolidate" in the earth observation section (line 652). Our thought is there is a whole requirements process out there to task all overhead systems and this is what should be used by the earth observation folks to task current systems. The earth observation community might say that their priorities are not high enough and therefore they can't get the data they need. The same could happen (and might be more of an issue) on a converged system. If in the requirements process there are shortfalls, ideas will be developed to meet those shortfalls which could include new systems, upgrade current systems, or possibly consolidate systems.

Based on our discussion Thurs, attached is my attempt to rewrite/shorten the National Security Space Activities section. On 26 Oct we proposed an earlier version of this rewrite to OSD, but you can see this was rejected by them in the 13 Nov draft. I've updated it somewhat to reflect some changes agreed to by us and OSD. The reason we didn't submit this to you on 14 Oct was we don't have a problem with OSD's language other than it was too detailed and too long.

Hope it helps.
