The Secretary-General of the United Nations presents his compliments to the Permanent Representative of the United States of America to the United Nations and has the honour to refer to the recent deterioration of the situation in Somalia and to Security Council resolution 837 (1993) of 6 June 1993, paragraph 8.

In order to deter any other violation of the cease-fire, the Secretary-General requests that the United States immediately deploy four additional attack helicopters to Somalia. It is proposed that the helicopters be included into and be supported by the United States Quick Reaction Force now supporting UNOSOM II.

The Secretary-General takes this opportunity to express his appreciation to the Government of the United States of America for its cooperation in contributing to this important United Nations operation. *4/R*

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Report concerning the incidents in Mogadishu on 5 June 1993

1. We have received the following information from the Secretary-General's Special Representative concerning the incidents in Mogadishu on 5 June 1993.

2. In mid-morning, several apparently organized demonstrations, roadblocks and armed attacks began throughout Mogadishu-South. Ostensibly these events were in protest of an Aidid-announced UNOSOM "seizure" of Radio Mogadishu (Aidid). No such seizure had taken place, nor was it intended. What had occurred, with prior written notice to Aidid's "ambassador", was a scheduled inventory of five militia weapons storage sites, one of which was at the radio transmission relay facility north of the city, with another at the radio broadcast studio in the city itself. While Aidid and USC/SNA are denying it, the activities which took place on 5 June 1993 appear to be a calculated, premeditated series of major ceasefire violations meant to challenge and intimidate UNOSOM II.

The sequence of events is as follows:

3. At 1600 hours on 4 June 1993, UNOSOM wrote letters to the United Somali Congress/Somali National Alliance (USC/SNA) faction in Mogadishu informing them of its plan to conduct weapons verification inspections of the authorized weapons storage sites (AWSS) in four locations in South Mogadishu and one site in Afgoy the next day. The last inspections had been conducted by UNITAF in January and February.

4. On the morning of 5 June 1993, the inspection began. Those at the Afgoy site and two of the four in Mogadishu were conducted without incident. The inspection at Site 5 - the "Mogadishu Radio (Aidid)" location - went smoothly until it was near

completion. At that time several agitators arrived on scene and began to incite the crowd which had gathered. At Site 4, a major storage site located at the Aidid radio re-transmission facility, the inspection team met some verbal resistance but were allowed to enter and conduct the inspection. At this site, the team was subject to sniper fire throughout the day. It was at Site 4 that a large number of weapons were found, including 62 tow missiles, two Milan missiles and one SA-7 which were later removed. Two technical vehicles previously in storage were no longer present. At about 1000 hours in other areas in South Mogadishu, demonstrations began and the UNOSOM Force Command headquarters was fired on. Pakistani and Turkish soldiers returned fire. Later, Pakistani units responding to incidents elsewhere in Mogadishu, transitted 21 October Road where they encountered a large, carefully prepared three-sided ambush which resulted in extensive casualties. The Quick Reaction Force was deployed in the afternoon to relieve the Pakistani forces pinned down in a facility known as the "cigarette factory" on 21 October Road. The Italians went to the assistance of Pakistanis trapped at feeding station 20.

5. Throughout the day, militia forces employed automatic weapons, RPG's and hand grenades. Serious disturbances continued throughout the day, including attacks on UNOSOM headquarters (where two hand grenades were thrown into its compound but did not explode), isolation and attack on Pakistani forces at checkpoints, random sniper attacks and armed roadblocks. The various attacks, in particular the large ambush resulted in an estimated 22 Pakistani soldiers killed, ten missing and 57 wounded (54 Pakistani, 3 United States). Casualties on the Somali side are believed to be high but their numbers are not yet known.

6. Contact with USC/SNA was difficult to establish during the morning due to the intensity of the disturbances around the

UNOSOM headquarters. The first contact was made through a UNOSOM national officer at 1300 hours. This was followed by an afternoon meeting between a UNOSOM official and two USC/SNA senior officials at USC/SNA headquarters, during which the USC/SNA attempted to disassociate itself from the incidents, asserting that the disturbances were spontaneous outbursts by an angry public. In light of the organized nature of the attacks, and several Aidid radio broadcasts accusing UNOSOM of wrongly shooting women and children without provocation, the USC/SNA disclaimer is difficult to accept. At an early evening meeting, even as USC/SNA emissaries were assuring UNOSOM officials of their good intentions and desire for restoration of peace, Aidid radio and vehicle mounted loudspeakers were continuing to agitate the public.

7. From the incidents of 5 June, it is clear that numerous weapons still remain with the public at large in Mogadishu. This will have to be factored into UNOSOM follow-up to the incidents, if security is to be maintained. Although investigations are not complete, the attacks constitute a gross violation of the ceasefire agreement and a blatant attack on United Nations troops.

8. Early on 6 June Aidid's personal broadcast over Radio Mogadishu fell far short of calming the situation as his emissaries had indicated was his intention. Instead, he articulated more anti-UNOSOM rhetoric, urged calm if UNOSOM acquiesced to his demands and violence if UNOSOM did not. At this juncture it would appear that Aidid is seeking a confrontation with UNOSOM in order to take control of the political reconciliation and judicial processes.

9. UNOSOM has sent a written message to General Aidid advising him of the United Nations and international community's outrage, and urging him to desist from the disastrous course he has set

for himself and his followers. This is the last opportunity for Aidid to become part of the peace process.

10. In order to better protect our civilian UNOSOM staff, international agency and NGO personnel, UNOSOM is consolidating into several more secure and logistically supportable locations. From these sites UNOSOM II will continue to accomplish all essential work. Meanwhile, Force Command is strengthening its posture and preparing for possible contingencies.

11. We should like to place on record our appreciation and admiration for the courageous and disciplined manner in which the Pakistani troops conducted themselves in very difficult circumstances.

12. The Secretary-General will keep the Council fully informed of further developments relating to the situation in Mogadishu.

Mr President, yesterday's actions by factional leaders of the USC, resulting in many deaths and injuries to UN forces, especially UNOSOM II forces from Pakistan, are an outrage and unacceptable. These actions threaten international peace and security and must be dealt with accordingly.

The United States supports today's resolution as the minimum required to restore the conditions for peace and reconciliation in Somalia. This Council, in a number of resolutions, leading up to resolution 814 establishing the mandate for UNOSOM II, has left no doubt about the imperative of establishing and maintaining a secure environment.

Factional violence is impermissible under the terms of resolution 814. It can and will be stopped. Hostilities aimed at UN forces are a gross violation of paragraph 9 of that resolution which " demands that all Somali parties, including movements and factions, take all necessary measures to ensure the safety of the personnel of the United Nations."

Today's resolution, Mr President, reaffirms the existing authority of UNOSOM II to take strong and forceful action to safeguard international forces, to punish those who attack them, and to restore security. Appropriate measures include the disarming and detention of persons posing a threat to UN forces or obstructing their operations. Those who would challenge the authority of this body to enforce its resolutions must know that we stand firm in our resolve to bring peace and reconciliation to Somalia and that they will pay a heavy price for ignoring the Council.

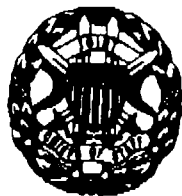
