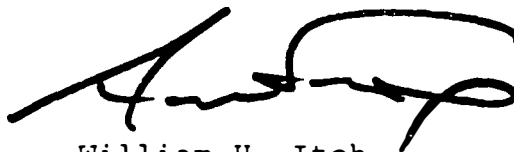

Thank you for your kind letter regarding my recent address to the United Nations General Assembly.

I believe you will find that the Report to Congress that I recently sent to you addresses most of the concerns you mentioned in your letter. The recent trip of Ambassador Oakley to Somalia and neighboring countries was the beginning of what I hope to be a successful political conclusion to the challenges faced in Somalia.

As you now know, I have refocused our efforts on finding a peaceful solution to the problems in Somalia and committed to staying in the UNOSOM II operation until March 31, 1993. It is a decision that I hope you will support. All US combat forces in Somalia will continue to remain under US command until they depart.

I am dedicated to the safety of our forces in Somalia and I will remain vigilant until the last U.S. soldier, sailor, airman and marine is withdrawn. In keeping with this mandate, I have ordered that sufficient combat forces be introduced into Somalia to ensure the security of all our personnel there. Our forces must have the capability to defend themselves.

Congressional support for our new policy in Somalia is essential in the coming months for the effectiveness and safety of our servicemen and women in Somalia. I look forward to working with you to assure success in this important mission.

Dear President Clinton:

So often in this field, we receive letters of criticism but never letters of commendation. This letter to you is the rarity in our field.

I had the opportunity to attend your address to the United Nations General Assembly and was received by a gracious hostess, the First Lady. I want to thank you for the fine accommodations granted on this visit.

In regard to your address, I was pleased to learn of our agreement that for the U.S. to say yes to peacekeeping, the U.N. must learn to say no. I want to reiterate my opposition to the placement of U.S. combat troops under foreign command, and it appears you are coming to the same realization.

I also strongly support your initiative to change the budget formula which establishes the annual contribution to the U.N. budget and peacekeeping activities. It is my hope that Ambassador Albright will make this one of her foremost priorities at the 48th UNGA.

I do want to register my concern, however, with the vagaries of your address concerning the Somali operation and the situation in the former Yugoslavia. I hope you are not developing an exit strategy for Somalia, only to implement a protracted involvement and military engagement in the former Yugoslavia. Certainly we should withdraw from Somalia immediately, bear the few days of negative publicity, and cut our losses. But Yugoslavia would be years of struggle costing hundreds of lives and billions of dollars. At the end, how will the U.S. be better off? In addition to the questions you posed in your address concerning general peacekeeping operations, I submit the most important but often overlooked question: would the mission truly serve U.S. interests? This should be the primary question deliberated when considering responses to the multiple conflicts currently raging globally.

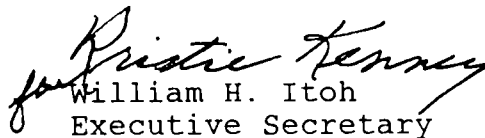

Dear Mr. President:

As you know, earlier this month I visited our forces in Somalia. During discussions with our soldiers stationed there, I was made aware of the fact that although our soldiers are authorized to receive Imminent Danger Pay, their location has not been designated a Combat Zone -- a designation which would allow these military personnel to gain certain tax benefits.

My observations during my visit to Somalia suggest to me that our troops are, in fact, in a combat zone. I realize that although it was never the intent for our soldiers to operate in a combat role in Somalia, it is my belief that today they are subject to conditions and expectations consistent with those of a combat zone.

It is my understanding that 26 USC 112 permits only the President the statutory authority to declare an area a combat zone. I hope that you will revisit this issue in order to ensure that appropriate compensation is given our soldiers serving in Somalia.

Thank you for your consideration — *this would be a great Xmas gift to the troops.*

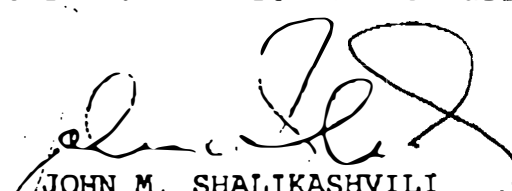

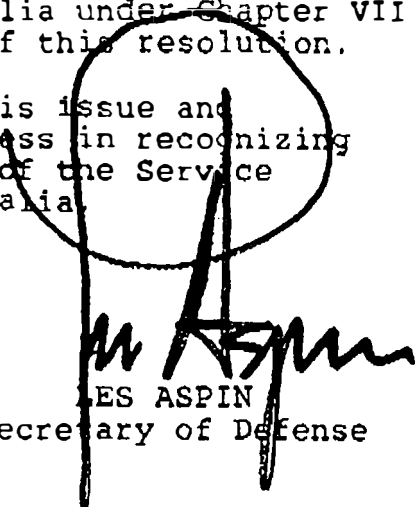
The Department of Defense strongly supports H.R. 494. This bill provides that members of the Armed Forces serving in the arduous humanitarian relief effort in Somalia are entitled, upon Presidential order, to a tax exclusion as though they had served in a combat zone as defined in title 26 USC, section 112. We also note that the FY 1994 Defense Appropriations Act contained a Sense of the Congress Resolution supporting a combat zone tax exclusion for Service members in Somalia.

The men and women of the Armed Forces serving in Somalia have served in a demanding environment under conditions of austerity, adversity, and hostility. Since Somalia was declared an area qualifying for Imminent Danger Pay, over 175 US combat casualties have occurred, including 26 valiant men who made the ultimate sacrifice, attesting to the dangerous conditions there.

We recommend H.R. 494 use a starting date of December 3, 1992, the date United Nations Resolution 794 was approved. US forces began their security mission in Somalia under Chapter VII of the United Nations Charter as a result of this resolution.

We would welcome your leadership on this issue and appreciate the interest of members of Congress in recognizing and compensating the courage and sacrifice of the Service members who have served so valiantly in Somalia.

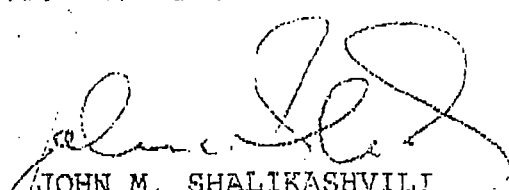

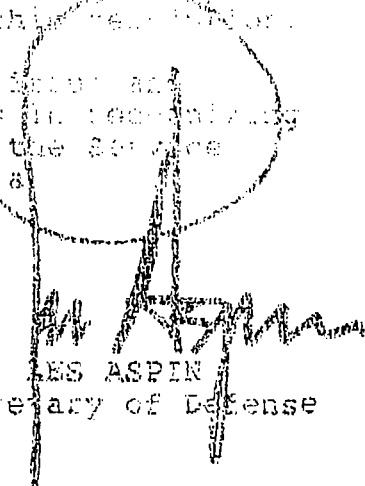
