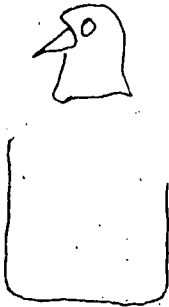

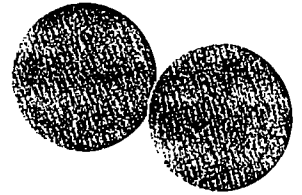

Purpose

To waive legal restrictions on providing assistance to support efforts to reestablish the Somali police force.

Background

The Department of Justice's International Criminal Investigative Training Assistance Program (ICITAP) will utilize funding made available by this waiver to provide urgently needed refresher training for the Somali police and important support for UNOSOM's police program.

In order to transfer the \$12 million in FY 94 PKO funds for Somalia to the Department of Justice, you must waive legal restrictions on providing such assistance.

The Department of State has completed formal consultations regarding this waiver with the Congress and no serious objections were raised.

Pursuant to the authority vested in me by section 614(a)(1) of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, 22 U.S.C. 2364(a)(1) (the "Act"), I hereby:

(1) determine that it is important to the security interests of the United States to furnish up to \$12 million under Chapter 6 of Part II of the Act, through funds appropriated for fiscal year 1994, for purposes of supporting efforts to reestablish police forces in Somalia, without regard to section 512 of the Foreign Operations, Export Financing, and Related Programs Appropriations Act, 1994 (Public Law 103-87), and sections 620Q and 660 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended (22 U.S.C. 2151 et seq.), or any other provision of law within the scope of section 614(a)(1) of the Act; and

(2) authorize the furnishing of such assistance.

You are hereby authorized and directed to transmit this determination to the Congress and to publish it in the Federal Register.

THE WHITE HOUSESUBJECT: Presidential Waiver of Statutory Restrictions on
Assistance to Somalia

This memorandum requests that the President sign the attached determination waiving legal restrictions on providing assistance to support efforts to reestablish the police force in Somalia.

On December 28, the Department of State recommended to the NSC that the President authorize the Department to consult with Congress concerning the proposed waiver under Section 614 of the Foreign Assistance Act (FAA) of the prohibitions against providing assistance for police and other prohibitions on aid to Somalia in order to provide up to \$12 million in Peacekeeping Operations (PKO) funds to support the reestablishment of an effective civilian police force in Somalia.

On January 7, the NSC informed the Department that the President had authorized consultations with Congress regarding the proposed waiver. Those consultations have been completed. No significant objections were raised. However, a number of concerns were noted, including: the need for a careful screening of trainees; the importance of proper oversight of police activities; a desire that the United States emphasize training outside Mogadishu; and the importance of contributions from other countries to the effort to reestablish the Somali police.

During consultations on this proposal, we advised the Congress that we did not intend to use the Section 614 authority to waive the reprogramming notification requirement applicable to this \$12 million, which has not been previously justified to Congress. Accordingly, once the President signs the Section 614 determination, we can provide the requisite 15-day reprogramming notification.

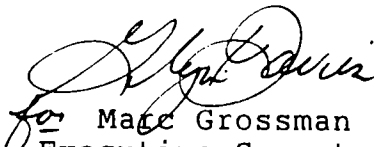

The reestablishment of an effective police force is a necessary prerequisite for creating an environment in which humanitarian assistance and national rehabilitation can continue to take place in Somalia. The United Nations Office in Somalia's (UNOSOM) Justice Division has reestablished many of the regional councils which will provide civilian oversight of the police and has acquired support for the program from other donors. The Department of Justice's International Criminal Investigative Training Assistance Program (ICITAP) proposal to be funded under this initiative will provide urgently needed refresher training for the Somali police and important additional support for UNOSOM's police program. The Department for these reasons believes it is important to the security interests of the United States that the President sign the attached determination to exercise his authority under Section 614 of the FAA and thus enable the furnishing of the necessary funding for this valuable program.
