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Press Guidance on Somalia

Background:

CNN is reporting that the U.S. plans to send 1900 troops to Somalia to assist the UN in its withdrawal. There is also a November 5th article in the San Diego Union - Tribune that says that preparations for this operation were "delayed because the White House did not want to announce a return to the war-torn nation just before Tuesday's midterm election." The U.S. government officially received a request for assistance for withdrawal on August 8, 1994.

Q: Is the U.S. planning to send U.S. troops back to Somalia to support UNOSOM's withdrawal?

A: The U.S. and other countries have received a request from the UN for assistance with the UNOSOM withdrawal. No decision has been made on this matter.

Q: The UN has been waiting on the U.S. decision since August. Did the administration purposefully wait to make this decision because of the Election?

A: No. However, we do plan to bring this matter up soon to the President. we have been working with the UN to clarify the request.
