Sandy:

Under State's lead, USG humanitarian agencies and bureaus prepared a Kosovo paper entitled "Humanitarian Relief and Human Rights in the Absence of a Political Settlement." As it was received too late for inclusion in the PC package, I wanted to brief you on its essential points/conclusions.

SUMMARY OF MAJOR POINTS

- Given the unsecure environment in Kosovo and limitations on access, **no level of humanitarian response will meet the majority of humanitarian needs in the the absence of a political settlement or military action to end violence and create a permissive aid delivery environment.**
- NGOs estimate that without an end to the fighting, they will be able to **delier aid to only a portion of the 250,000 to 400,000 internally displaced persons in Kosovo, perhaps only one-third.**
- The remainder **may survive the winter in substandard housing or with insufficient foods stocks,** flee to other countries, or die of exposure or insufficient food and medicine.
- Even if the harsh winter produces a lull in fighting, slightly improved access for humanitarian agencies, and the possibility of greater numbers of returns (though this is by no means certain), it is likely that fighting will resume in the spring, thus displacing additional tens of thosuands and setting back any progress that the aid community might make on improving conditions.
- **At this point, our strategy cannot rely on large-scale returns of IDPs to their homes, given continued Serb attacks.**
- Thus, we seek to establish a broad distribution network through bases of operation in four sites: Pristina, Pec, Mitrovica and Prizen. These hubs will be for the stockpiling and delivery of commodities to IDPs in place – wherever they are.
- If Serb attacks continue into the winter, there are no good options for effective humanitarian assistance delivery.
- **Airdrops are likely to be ineffective because it is difficult to target moving populations, and planes would be highly vulnerable to attack.**
- In the absence of a credible threat of force, UNPROFOR-like troop deployments would require Milosevic's approval, and would create the same problems that UNPROFOR experienced: e.g., attacks on troops, less than secure environment for delivery of relief even with troops on the ground, etc.
