Settlement Issues:

PM to work with Jim O'Brien: Need to ensure settlement provides broad authority for an augmented KVM to implement the settlement. In particular, settlement should make KVM Director the ultimate authority to interpret the settlement.

Task a paper: Need to develop a strategy to address incremental non-compliance, outline actions needed to maintain the credibility of NATO military force, and identify points of leverage that can help ensure continued compliance.

Yes. I would like to use the Excomm to push PRM on their role as the humanitarian sub group chair, and to push on a pilot shelter program.

1. UNHCR/NGO IDP/housing survey. I suggest that we ask PRM to clarify updated numbers of displaced/returns, and what this means in terms of the assistance strategy.

While there has not been interagency discussion on this, as PRM has not called any sub group meetings, we can give them a heads up that this is on the agenda so that PRM can prepare (and consult with OFDA and others) to report out, but then utilize the inclusion of humanitarian affairs on the agenda to push PRM to more actively convene this sub group. I have already raised my concern with Marguerite Houze, and she said that because she has been traveling and was being pulled in a lot of directions, Office Director David Appleton would be chairing the sub group and she would urge him to move quickly on this.

(Marguerite is good and I respect that she is pulled lots of ways. However, if you plan to be a stickler on AS-level chairmanship of sub groups, note that PRM has already delegated down.)

2. Housing reconstruction. I suggest that we ask Rick Barton to report on ways to jumpstart housing reconstruction now, and ask for a 1-2 page strategy for the next Excomm meeting

I have raised the concept with Rick Barton of linking the humanitarian and reconstruction committees to launch a quick impact USAID-led pilot shelter program (as USAID did in Bosnia). Rick is keen on this, but we need to light a fire under him to make it happen, and he will probably need our weight to help push this through his own Agency. Rick is supposed to be coordinating a small meeting between me, OFDA and him to discuss today or tomorrow. The concept is that USAID would solicit proposals to reconstruct a specific, small number of houses in specific villages (with villages selected based on a combination of humanitarian need, sufficient security, places we want to send a message to UCK that peace has its benefits, and areas where the likelihood of success is high.) USAID would fund these projects -- not channel funds through the OSCE -- utilizing either OFDA or OTI money, but the pilot project could serve as a model for a broader, OSCE-managed, housing reconstruction effort.

Terms of Reference for
the Kosovo Executive Committee

BACKGROUND: On October 28, the NSC Deputies Committee agreed to establish a Kosovo ExComm co-chaired by the NSC and Department of State. The NSC Executive Secretary notified agencies of the ExComm's establishment in a November 2 memorandum and designated as co-chairs the Special Assistant to the President for Implementation of the Dayton Accords (Greg Schulte) and the Special Representative for Kosovo Implementation (Ambassador James Pardew). The ExComm will function under U.S. policy guidelines outlined in PDD-56, the Clinton Administration's Policy for Managing Complex Contingency Operations dated 20 May 1997. The Kosovo ExComm is a formal interagency decision-making body that reports directly to the Deputies regarding the day-to-day implementation of U.S. policy in Kosovo. Agencies designated for ExComm membership will take appropriate measures to ensure their full and effective participation.

COMPOSITION: The Kosovo ExComm will consist of Assistant Secretary-level representatives who can be represented on a day-to-day basis by officials at the Deputy Assistant Secretary level who have authority to implement U.S. policy by committing agency personnel, assets and funds to execute specific program tasks. (See Tab B-ExComm Membership). Since the ExComm is a formal USG decision-making entity, participation at the Assistant Secretary or Deputy Assistant Secretary-level is a primary obligation.

MISSION: The Kosovo ExComm is responsible to the Deputies Committee for day-to-day interagency oversight and implementation of USG policy decisions and approved pol-mil plans. Specifically, the ExComm keeps pace with the implementation of the NATO and OSCE verification agreements, assesses current activities, sets priorities for action, anticipates problems with regard to the political settlement and its implementation, and proceeds with the implementation of the various components of the pol-mil plan for Kosovo. The ExComm reports to the Deputies concerning progress in implementation and, when necessary, seeks policy guidance.

SCOPE OF EFFORT: The ExComm is charged with managing the full range of issues regarding the crisis in Kosovo. The broad scope includes, but is not limited to, the following matters:

- Compliance by the parties of the agreement
- NAC deliberations and NATO operations
- OSCE planning and management activities
- NATO coordination and support to KVM
- KDOM operations and integration into KVM
- KVM start-up and verification operations
- Negotiations leading to a political settlement
- Implementation of a political settlement

OPERATING CONCEPT: ExComm meetings will normally be held at 1100-1230 on Tuesdays and Fridays in Room 208 OEOB. NSC will prepare the meeting agenda, assign reporting responsibilities and distribute a written summary of conclusions.

ORGANIZATIONAL ARRANGEMENTS: The ExComm will be supported by interagency sub-working groups to plan, organize and implement U.S. policy decisions and prepare issues for ExComm decision. At the onset the following sub-working groups are constituted:

- Kosovo Policy IWG w/Chair Greg Schulte
- KVM and Peace Settlement SWG w/Chair Jim Pardew
- Pol-Mil Planning SWG w/Chair Bob Beecroft
- Police and Justice SWG w/Chair Mike Sheehan
- Humanitarian Relief SWG w/Chair Marguerite Houze
- Democracy and Human Rights SWG w/Chair Leslie Gerson
- International Public Information SWG w/Chair Jamie Metzl
- Civil Society and Reconstruction SWG w/Chair Rick Barton

AREAS of RESPONSIBILITY: Each ExComm member shall be responsible for effective implementation of a portion of ExComm's scope of responsibilities. These areas are outlined in TAB A. As means of ensuring integration of agency planning efforts, ExComm members will chair interagency sub-working groups outlined above.

OVERSIGHT: The Deputies Committee exercises oversight over the Kosovo ExComm.
